# Methodology & Sample Profile

This study was conducted by AtlasIntel, an independent research & data intelligence firm.

1100 random interviews of South Carolina registered voters were conducted online between February 25 and February 28 2020. The sample was post-stratified with propensity scores to match the profile of registered voters on the following variables: gender, region, age group, education, family income, race, and vote in the 2016 Presidential Elections. The margin of error for registered voters is +/-3% at the 95% confidence level. The margin of error for likely Democratic Primary voters is +/-4% at the 95% confidence level. 477 voters declared that they would be voting in the South Carolina Democratic Primary.

State-level results are representative of registered voters. Democratic Primary results are provided for likely voters. Some percentages do not add up to 100% due to rounding.

8 questions are not reported in this public report.

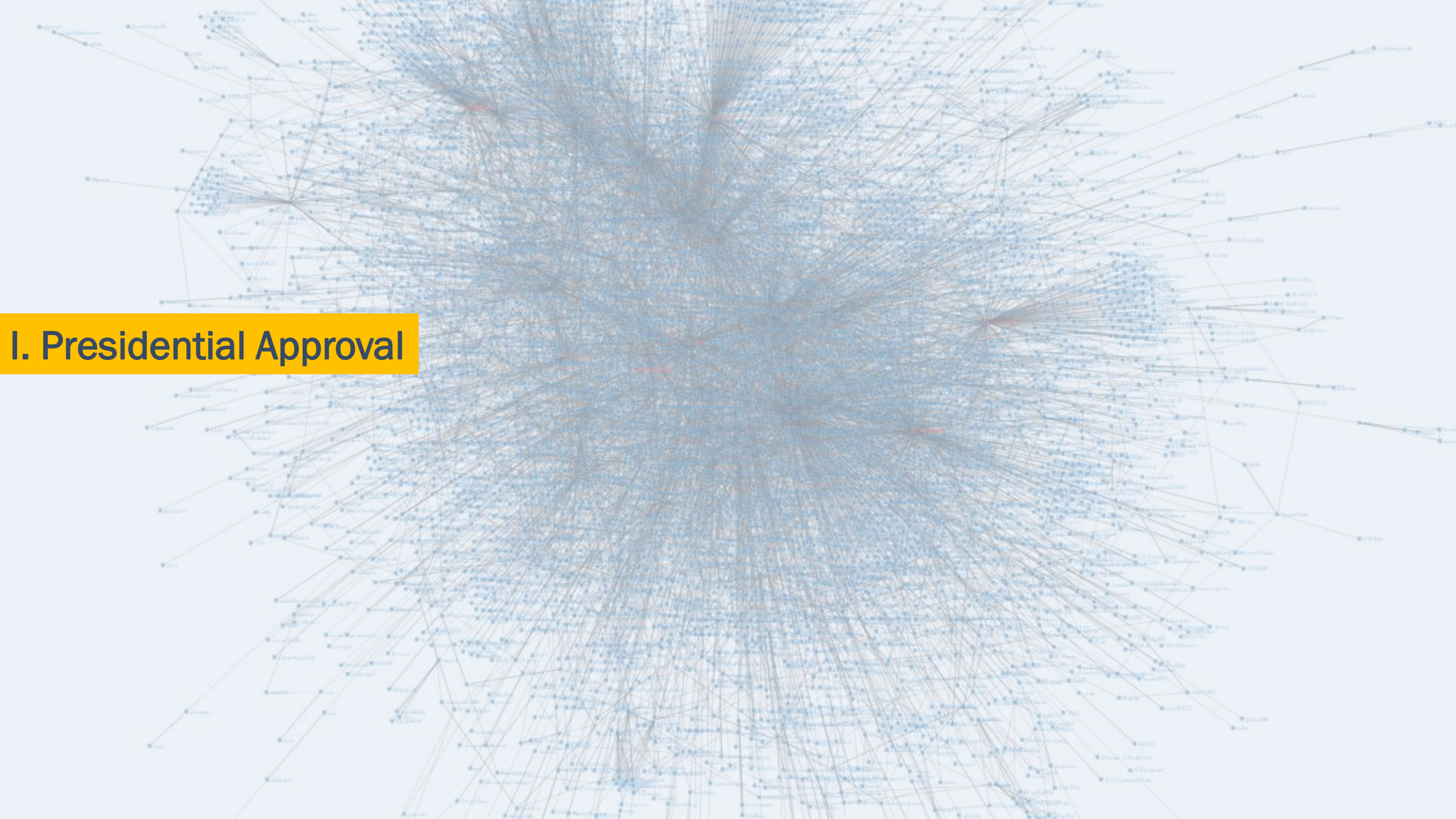

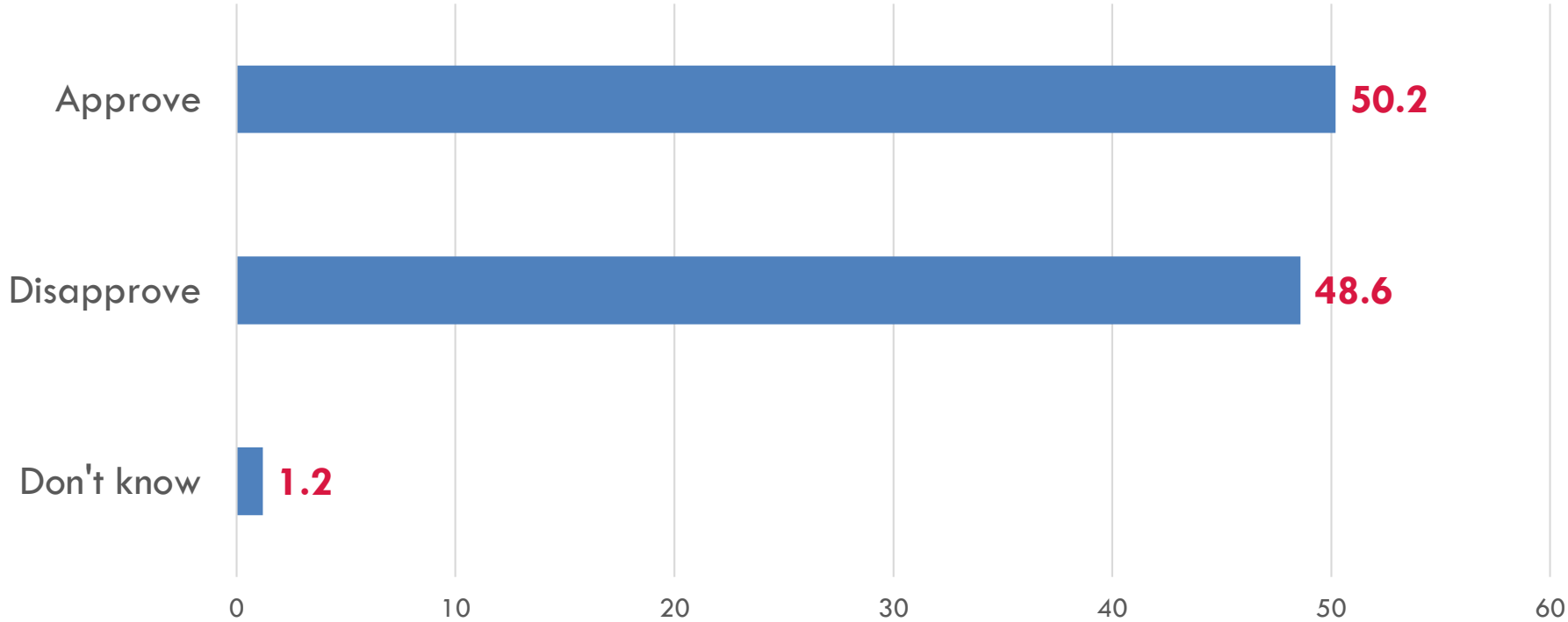

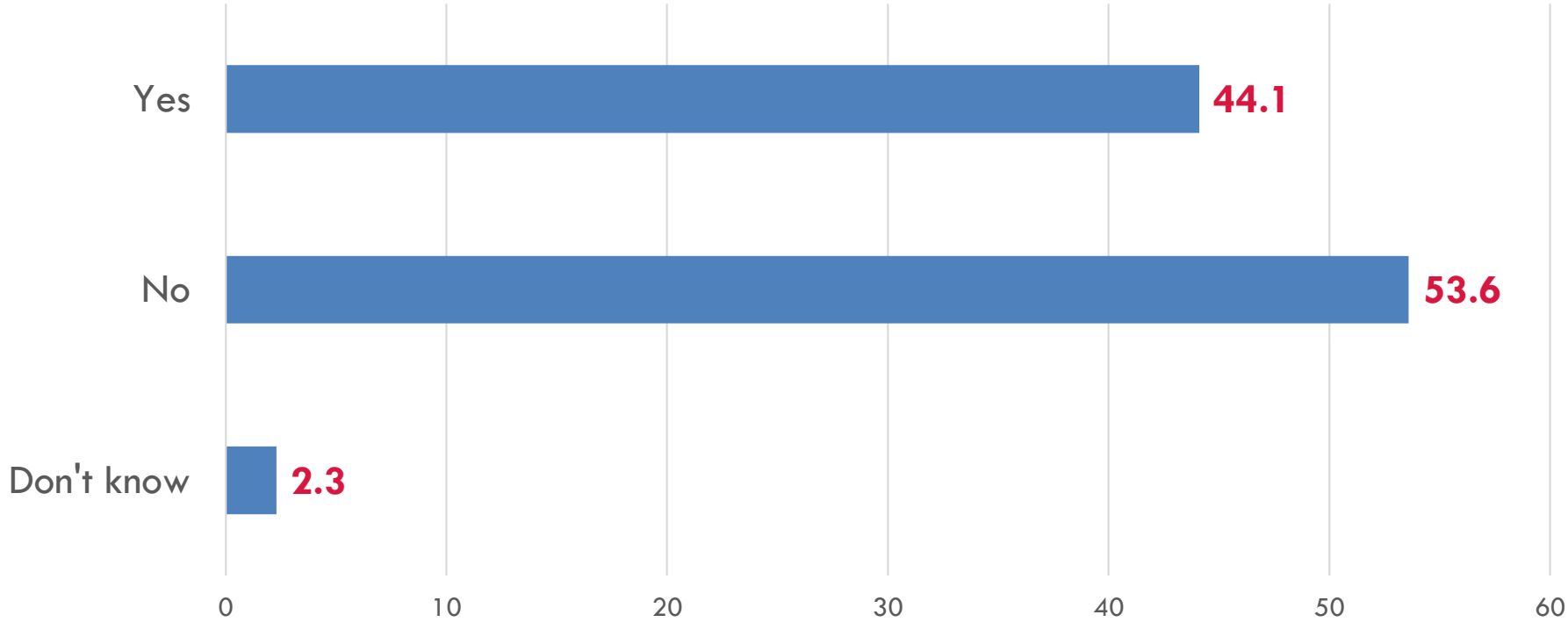
# Do you approve or disapprove of the job Donald Trump is doing as president?

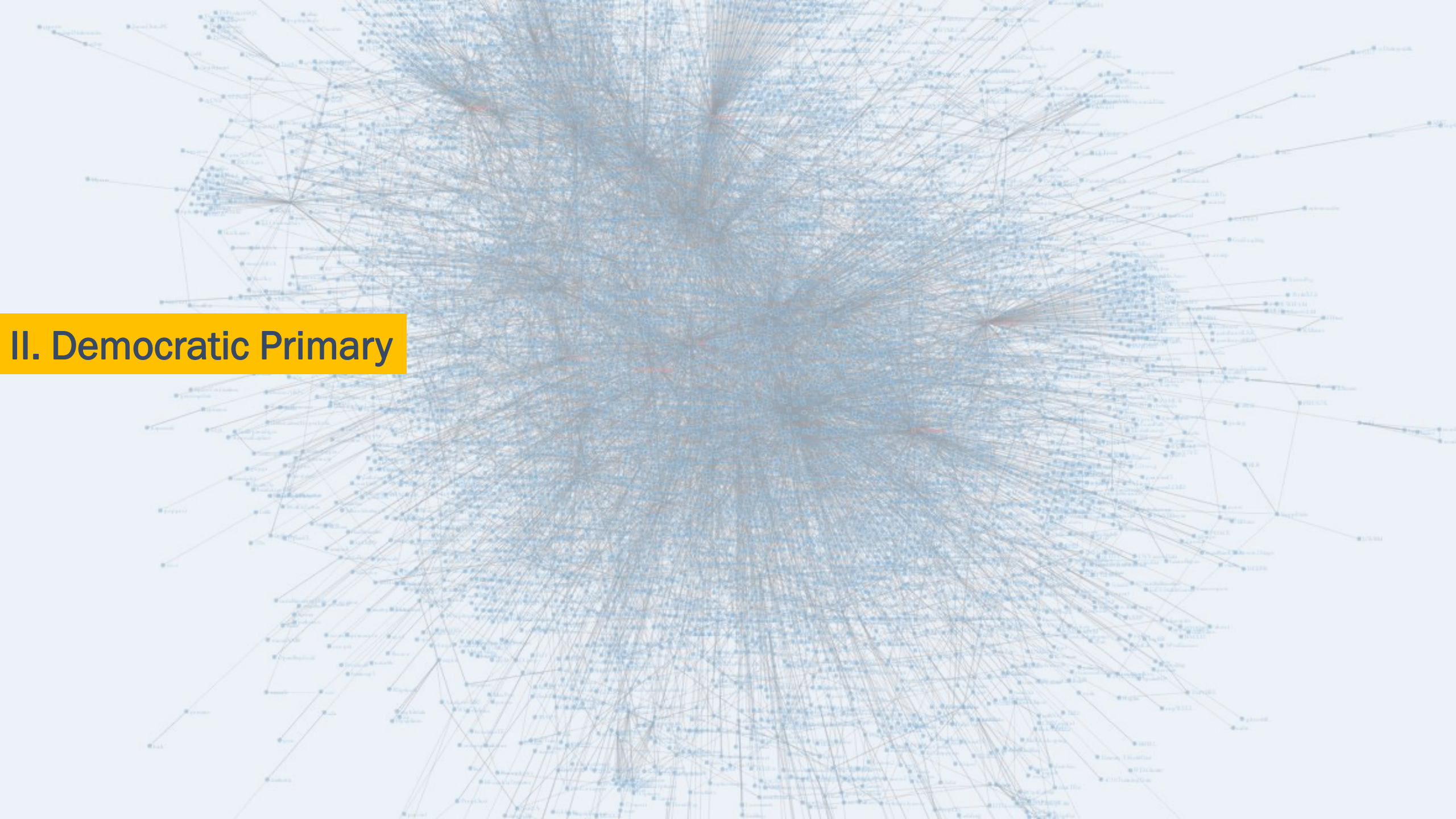


# Do you think President Trump should be impeached and removed from office?

### Which of these following Democratic Primary candidates will you vote for?

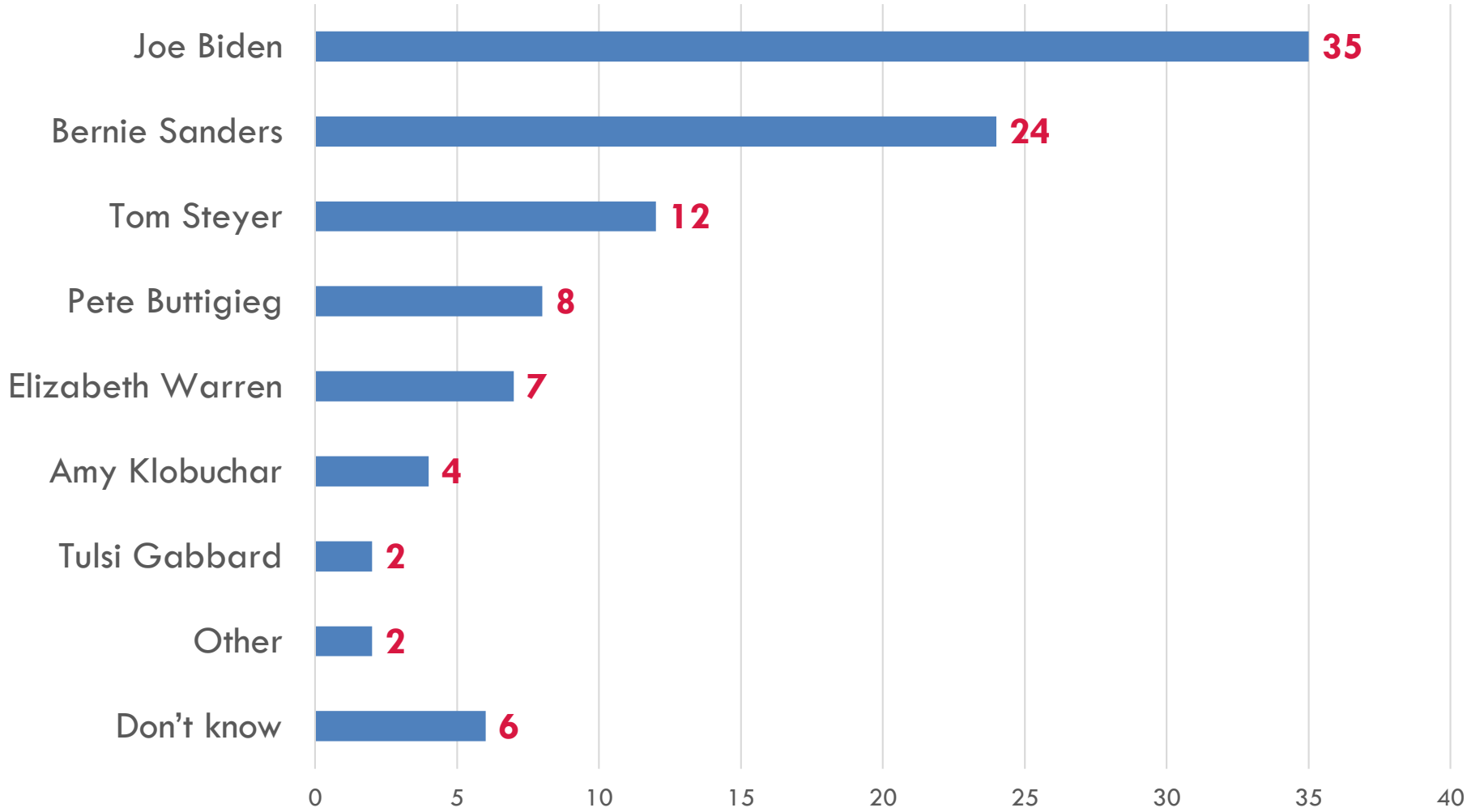

Asked solely of respondents declaring that they intend to vote in the South Carolina Democratic Primary



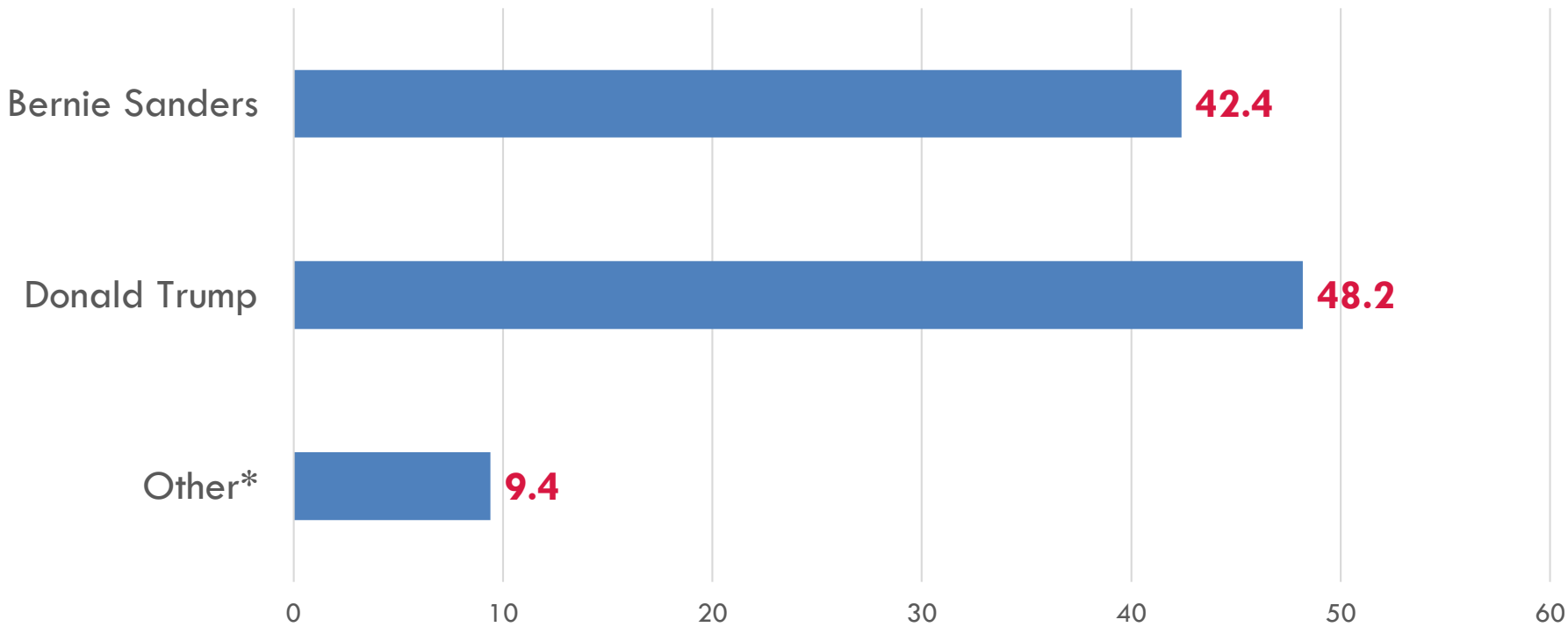

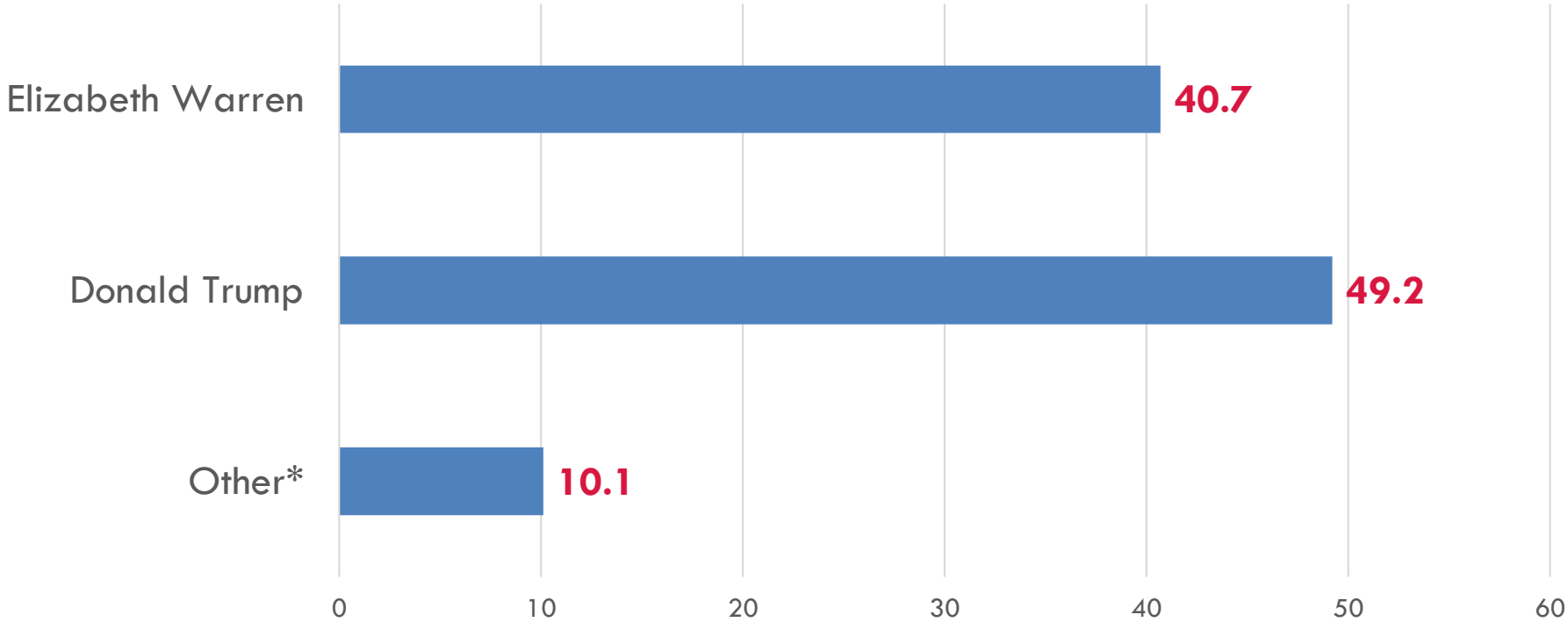
# If the Democratic candidate was Bernie Sanders, whom would you vote for in the US presidential elections?

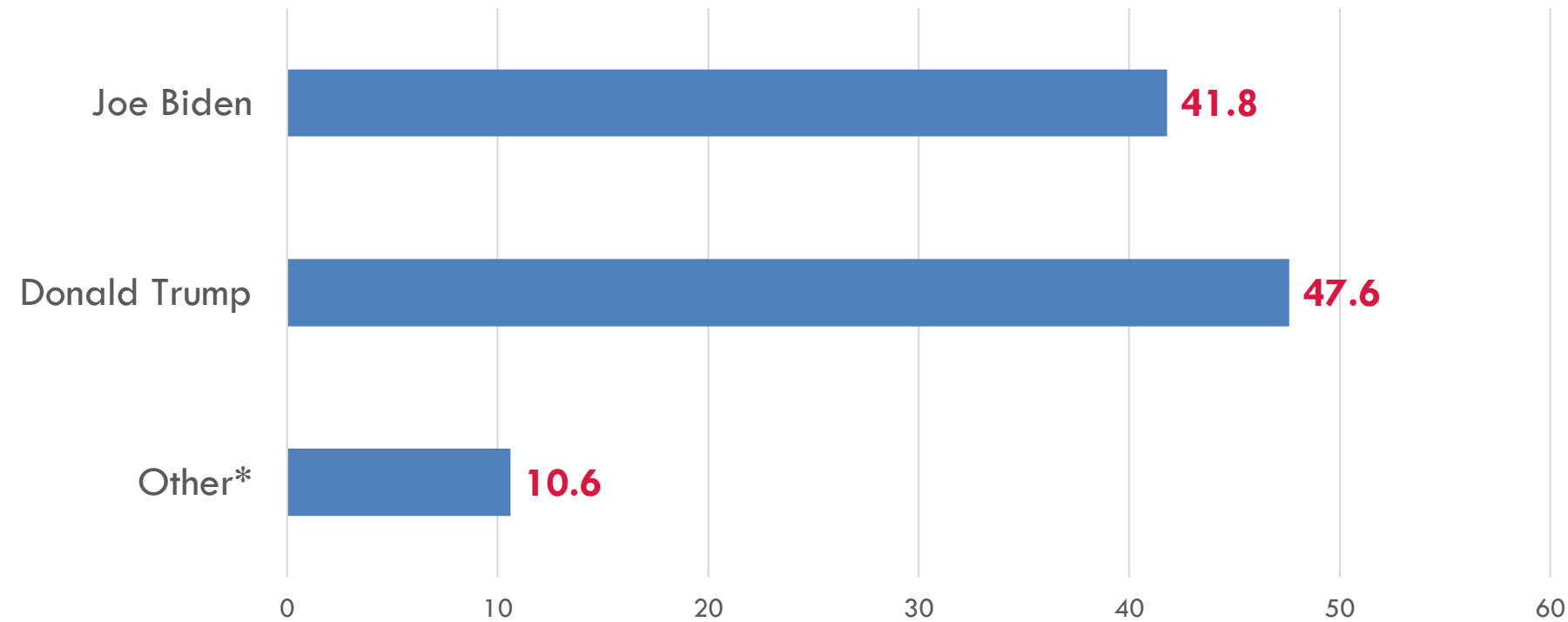
# If the Democratic candidate was Elizabeth Warren, whom would you vote for in the US presidential elections?

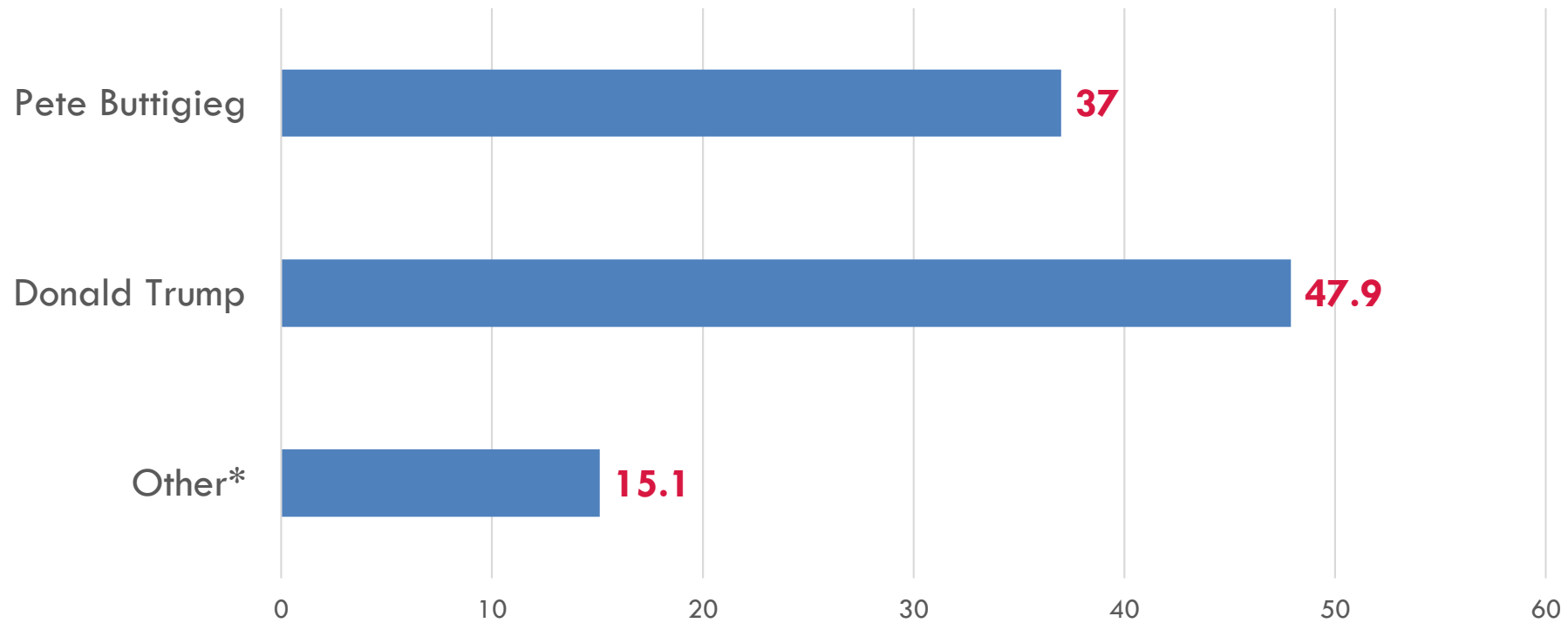
# If the Democratic candidate was Joe Biden, whom would you vote for in the US presidential elections?
