## **Nelson Research Releases New Oregon Gubernatorial Poll Results**

**Salem, Ore.** — A recent poll commissioned by the Associated General Contractors Oregon-Columbia Chapter shows that Oregon’s Gubernatorial race is extraordinarily competitive.

The poll of 620 likely Oregon voters found that with six weeks until election day, Republican Christine Drazan is garnering 33.4% support, followed by Democrat Tina Kotek with 31.5%, and independent candidate Betsy Johnson with 19.2%. 16% of voters are undecided.

Survey research data was gathered through live telephone interviews and secure SMS-text based surveys conducted with 620 likely voters registered to vote in Oregon. The interviews and surveys were completed September 19th and 20th, 2022. The overall estimated margin of sampling error is +/- 3.9 percent, based on a 95-percent confidence level.
