NEW POLL: Hung Cao Surging 21 Days to Election

Cao in dead heat with Jennifer Wexton in Biden +19 District

Purcellville, VA. - Today, the Cao campaign released a new internal poll that shows Hung Cao, a Republican congressional candidate in Virginia's Tenth District, in a dead heat with two-term incumbent Jennifer Wexton. The poll conducted between October 11-13 showed that 41% of likely voters in the district would cast their ballot for Hung Cao, compared to 43% of respondents who said they would vote for Wexton. Joe Biden won the district in 2020 by 19%, and Terry McAuliffe carried the region by 2% in the 2021 gubernatorial race.

Since Cao has blown Wexton out of the water in their <u>first two</u> congressional debates, his opponent has taken a hard turn towards negative TV broadcasting ads. VA-10 is highly competitive for Republicans, and Jennifer Wexton is worried.

Hung Cao outraised his opponent by more than 50% in Q3 and has received contributions from 22,400 supporters across the country. He is one of eleven GOP challengers to raise over a million dollars.

"It is pretty easy to figure out why Jennifer Wexton is resorting to a scorched-earth campaign," said Tim Saler, Cao campaign spokesman. "Wexton's record is indefensible. She is partisan first and foremost, so she chooses to tear people down when she is incapable of building Virginia up. Hung Cao is a bonafide American hero, a refugee from Vietnam who dedicated twenty-five years of honorable service to the country that saved his life."

The poll was conducted among 400 likely voters through Virginia's Tenth District with a 4.9% MOE.
