



These results are based on responses from 1,784 Americans collected between September 28 and October 2, 2023, via the Premise smartphone application. The results on policy issues are for all 1,784 Premise respondents in this sample. Results for candidate preferences are reported for all respondents in the sample as well as just for 1,337 respondents who self-identified registered voters. The number of respondents for questions on current events vary based on knowledge of the events. Premise used stratified sampling of its opt-in panel members, along with post-stratification weighting based on the American Community Survey, to provide a representative sample. These results are weighted by Age, Gender, Region and Education.
