Re: NY-16 Poll Shows Latimer In Strong Position To Unseat Bowman

Date: April 3, 2024

This analysis is based on the findings of a survey of 400 voters in New York's 16th Congressional District representing the likely June 2024 Democratic primary electorate. The survey uses a registration-based sample, with interviews conducted via landline, cell, and text-to-online from March 26-30, 2024. The margin of error for the sample as a whole is +/- 4.9% at the 95% level of confidence (higher for subgroups).

While this race is yet to be run and much can happen, our just-completed survey reveals that Westchester County Executive George Latimer is in strong position to defeat incumbent Congressman Jamaal Bowman in the June 2024 Democratic primary.


LATIMER ENJOYS A DOUBLE-DIGIT LEAD OVER BOWMAN

Latimer has a 17-point lead in the horse race, with 52% of the Democratic primary vote, compared to 35% for Bowman, 0% for Farber, and 13% undecided.

Indeed, Latimer's strong support (40%) exceeds Bowman's total support (35%).

Among those who vote most often in primaries (3 or 4 of the last 4), Latimer is even

stronger, leading Bowman by 56% to 35%.



LATIMER LEADS BECAUSE HE HOLDS A HUGE IMAGE ADVANTAGE


Latimer's double-digit lead results from his substantial image advantage. For example, while voters are quite positive about Latimer's performance in office (68% positive, 18% negative) they judge Bowman's performance quite negatively (36% positive, 55%).

negative). Latimer does 32-points better on the positive side, while Bowman's negatives are a massive 37-points higher than Latimer's. Very few unindicted elected officials receive such strongly negative ratings from their co-partisans.

This represents a dramatic deterioration in Bowman's image. Since July of 2022, Bowman's positive job ratings dropped by 14 points in a mostly overlapping district, while his negative ratings rose by a whopping 27 points. The disappointment with Bowman is palpable, as are the plaudits Latimer has earned.

The power of Latimer's image advantage is evident in the fact that among those who know



both Latimer and Bowman (76% of the electorate), Latimer's lead expands to 26 points (60% to 34%).

And that image advantage extends well beneath the surface. For example, where two years ago a decisive 60% to 13% majority thought Bowman cared about people like them, today his constituents are divided, with only 45% now saying he cares about them while 35% say he does not.

By comparison, 66% think Latimer cares about people like them while just 11% believe he does not.

BOWMAN IS OUT OF TOUCH WITH HIS CONSTITUENTS ON ISRAEL ISSUES

By 59% to 28%, Democratic primary voters approve of the job Joe Biden is doing handling the war between Israel and Hamas. In addition, 62% of Democratic primary voters want the US to support Israel in the current conflict while a mere 5% want the US to back Hamas.

CONCLUSION

The data are clear: With a robust campaign, the well-known and highly regarded Latimer is in strong position to unseat the now unpopular Bowman.
