**RE:** New polling in 3 major battlegrounds show growing drumbeat for Biden replacement

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*This memo summarizes the key findings from online surveys conducted in Pennsylvania, Arizona, and Michigan in the 48 hours following the debate between Joe Biden and Donald Trump on June 27th. Surveys were conducted among both likely Democratic voters and self-reported registered voters across both parties. All samples are demographically representative of the electorate and weighted according to 2020 census data.*

1a ) 341 Likely Dem Voters in Pennsylvania, MOE is 5.31

1. Only 33% say Biden won the debate and 62% say he is mentally fit for office.
2. 28% say they are either less likely or much less likely to vote for Biden in November.
3. 53% say it would be beneficial to have a new Democratic nominee for president.

1b ) 741 Likely GE Voters in Pennsylvania, MOE is 3.6

1. Trump up +5% when asked who would you vote for if the election were held today.
  - a. Donald Trump 46%
  - b. Joe Biden 41%
  - c. RFK Jr. 3%
  - d. Chase Oliver 0.5%
  - e. Undecided 9%
2. 49% disapprove or strongly disapprove of Biden's job performance.
3. 54% say Biden is mentally unfit to lead. Only 34% say he is.

2a ) 262 Likely Dem Voters in Michigan, MOE is 6.05

4. Only 40% say Biden won the debate and 65% say he is mentally fit for office.
5. 26% say they are either less likely or much less likely to vote for Biden in November.
6. 45% say it would be beneficial to have a new Democratic nominee for president.

8. 32% say they are either less likely or much less likely to vote for Biden in November.
9. 49% say it would be beneficial to have a new Democratic nominee for president.

3b ) 492 Likely GE Voters in Arizona, MOE is 4.42

  - a. Donald Trump 48%
  - b. Joe Biden 33%
  - c. RFK Jr. 8%

  - e. Undecided 9%
8. 58% disapprove or strongly disapprove of Biden's job performance.
9. 60% say Biden is mentally unfit to lead. Only 31% say he is.
