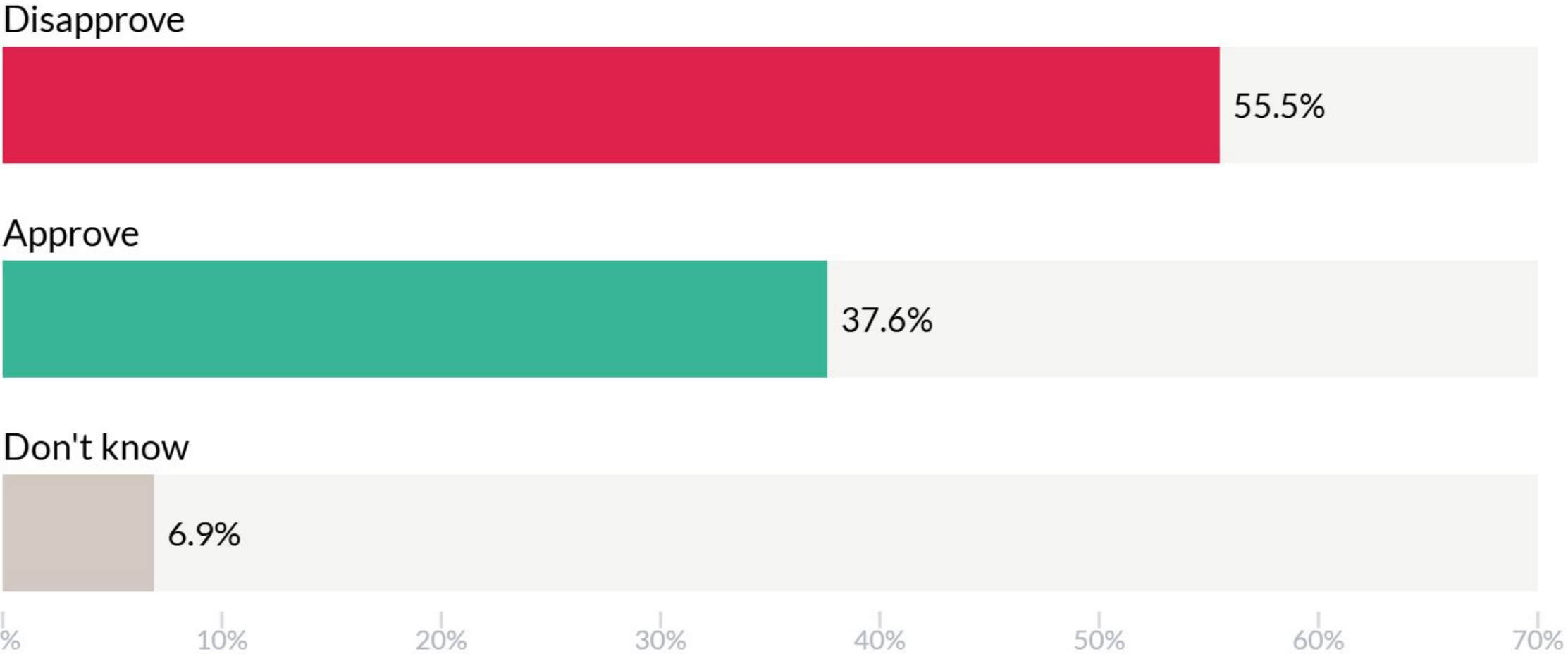

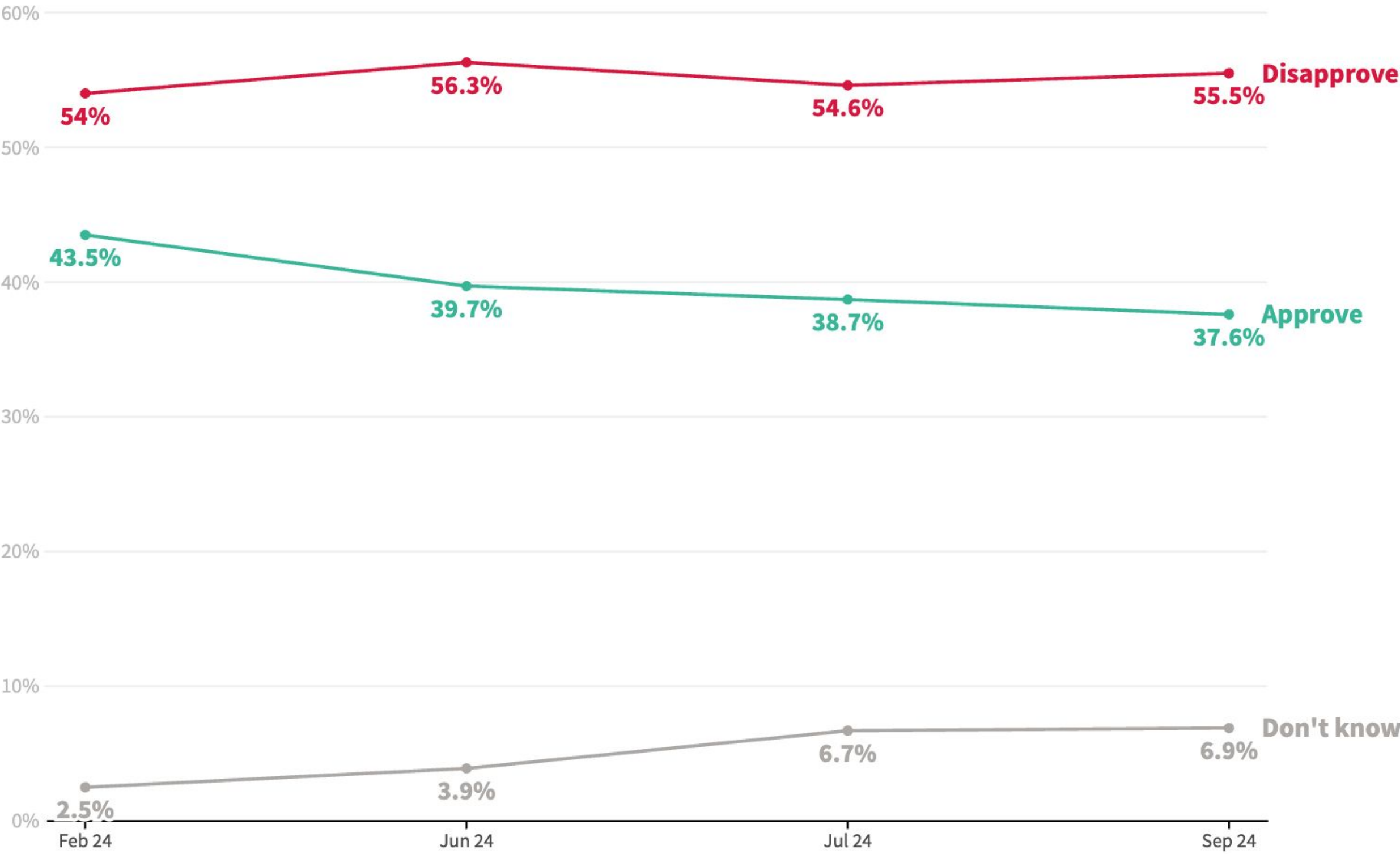

Do you approve or disapprove of Joe Biden's performance as president of the United States?

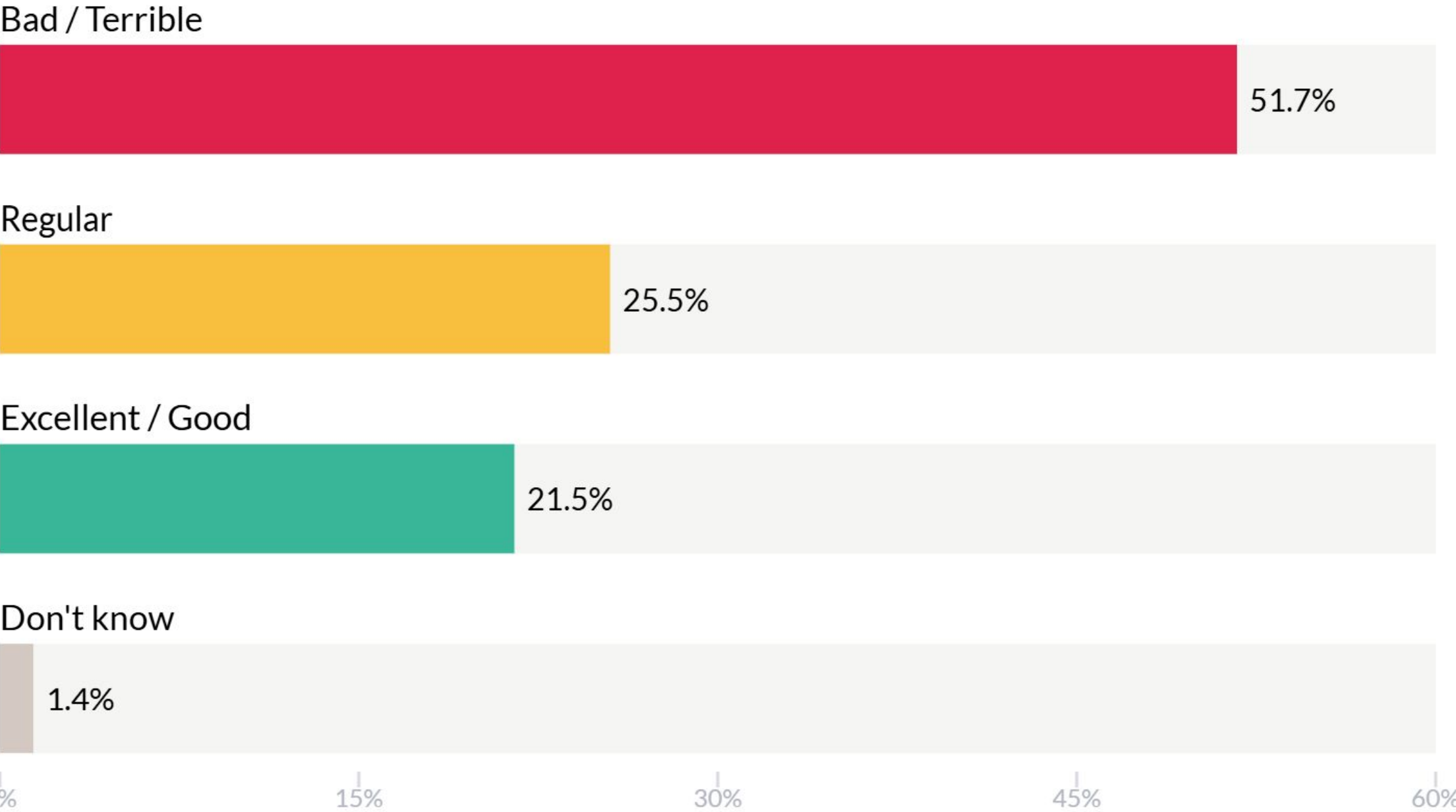

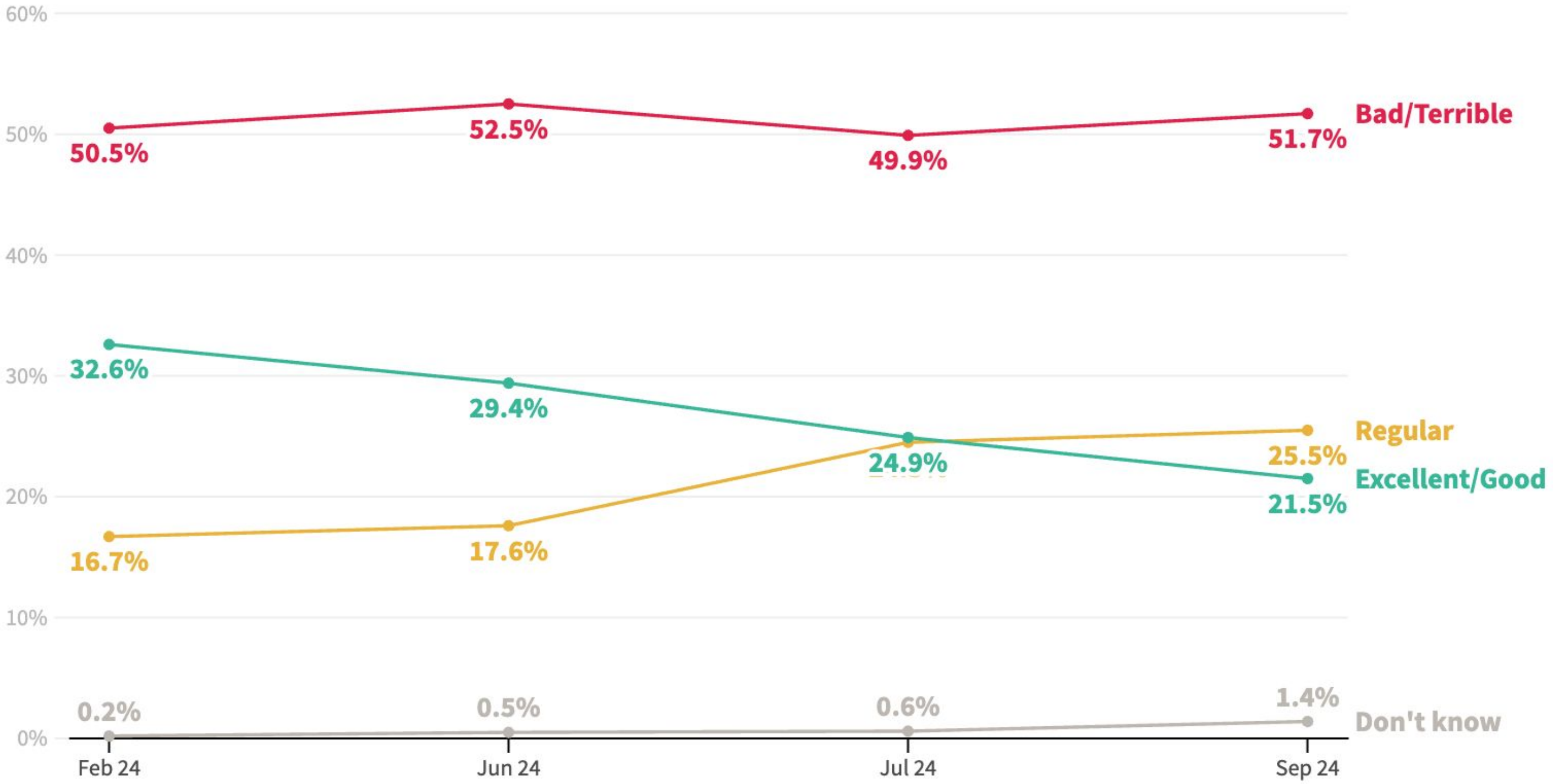

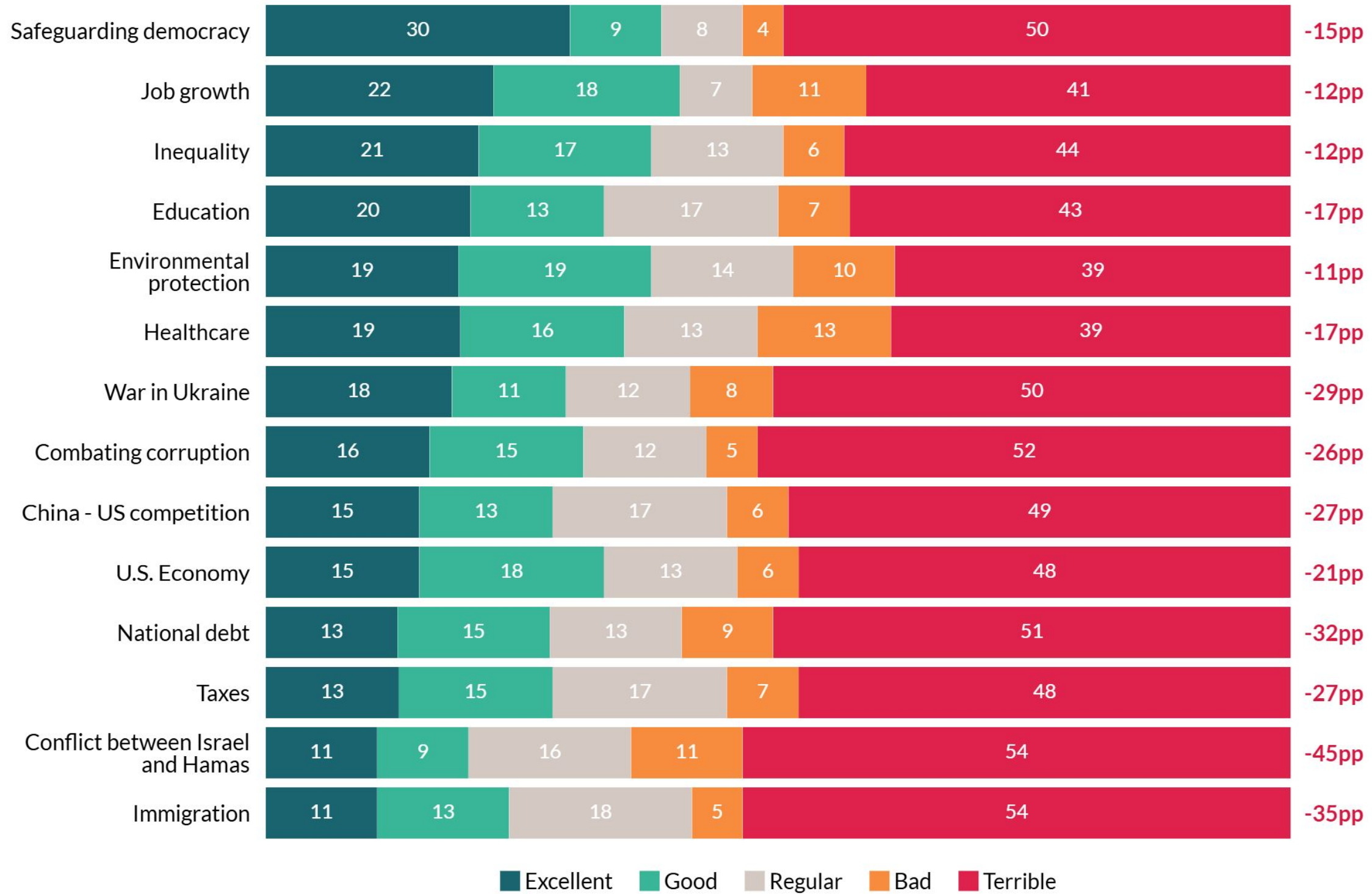

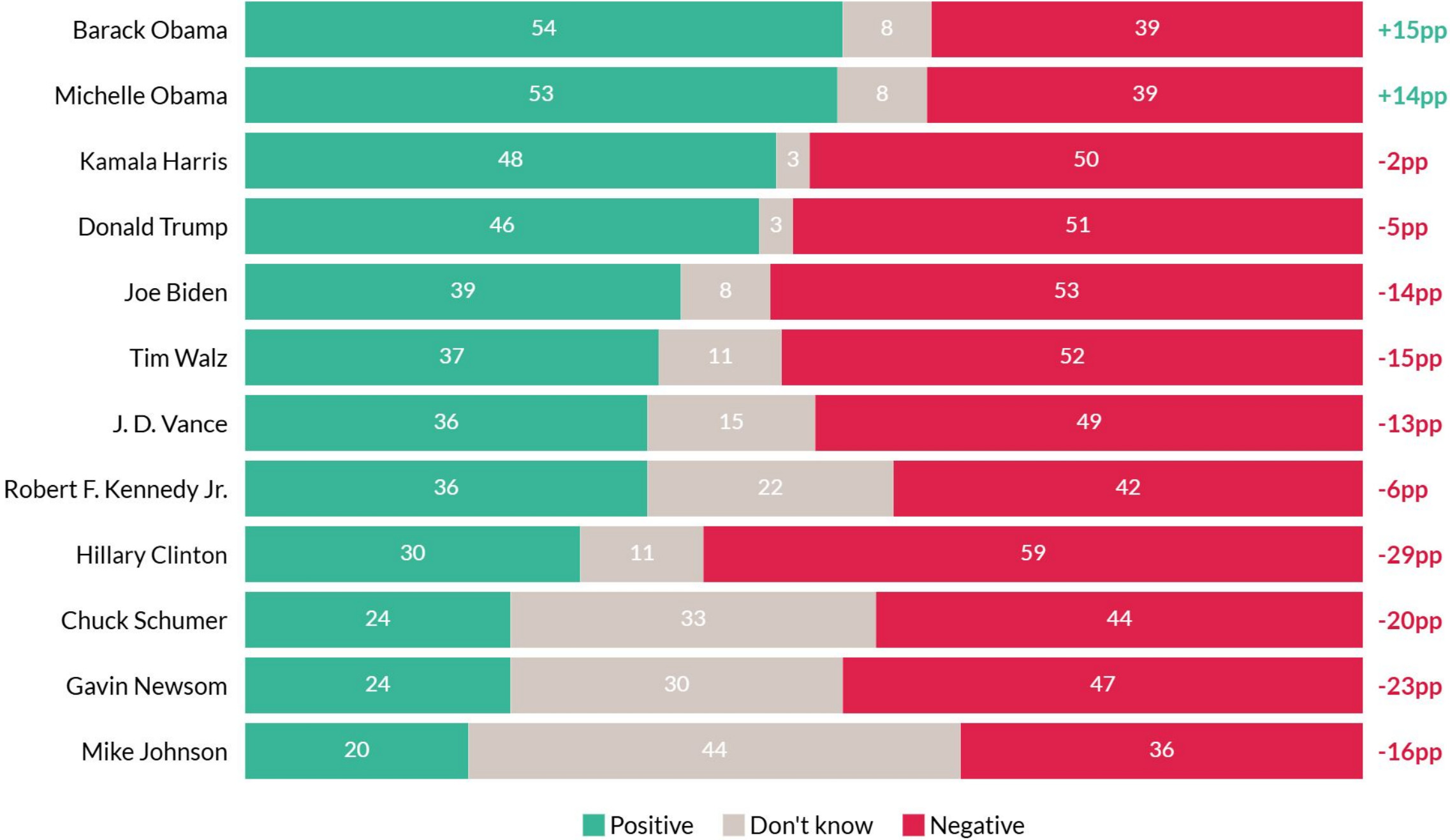

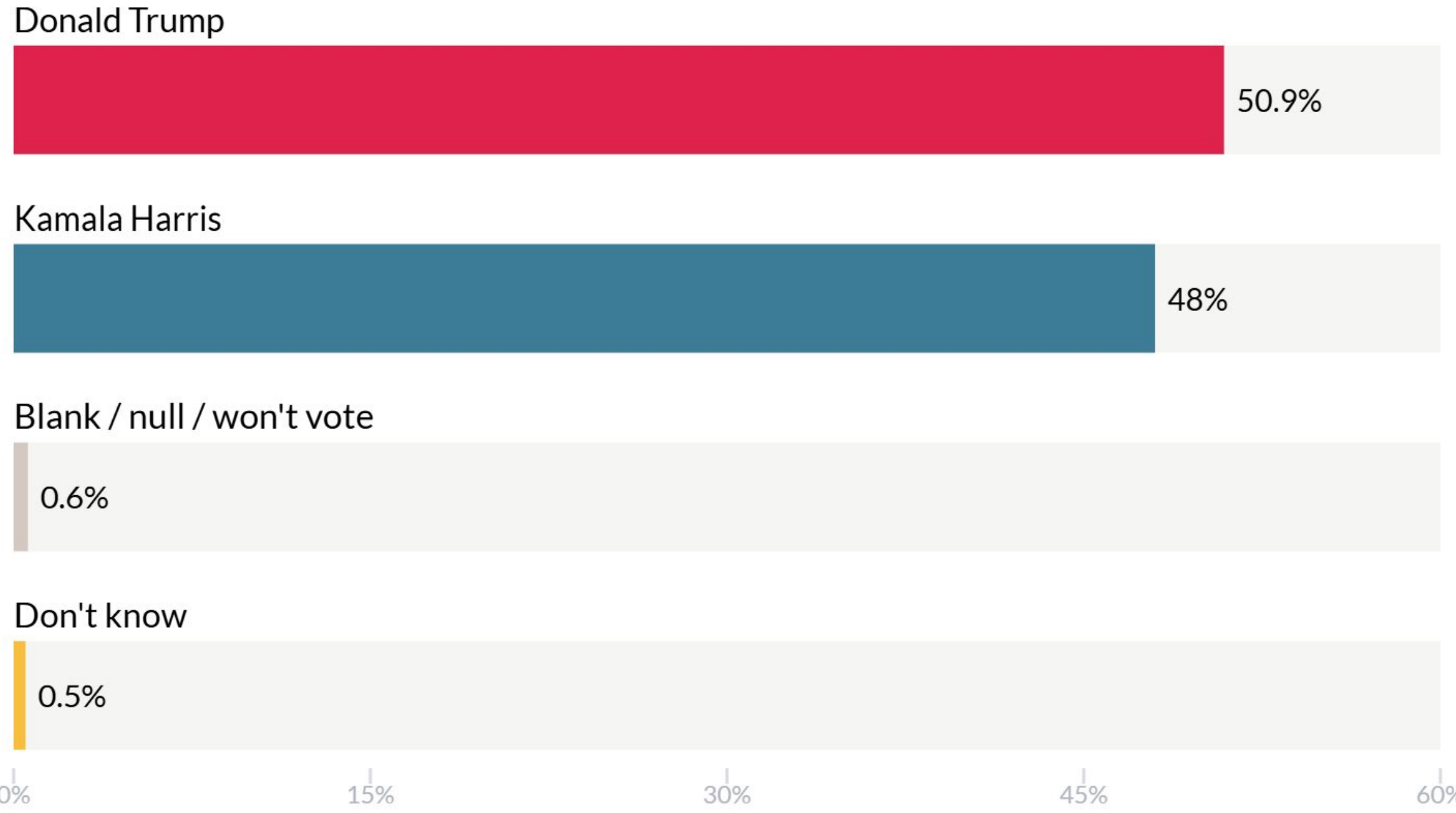

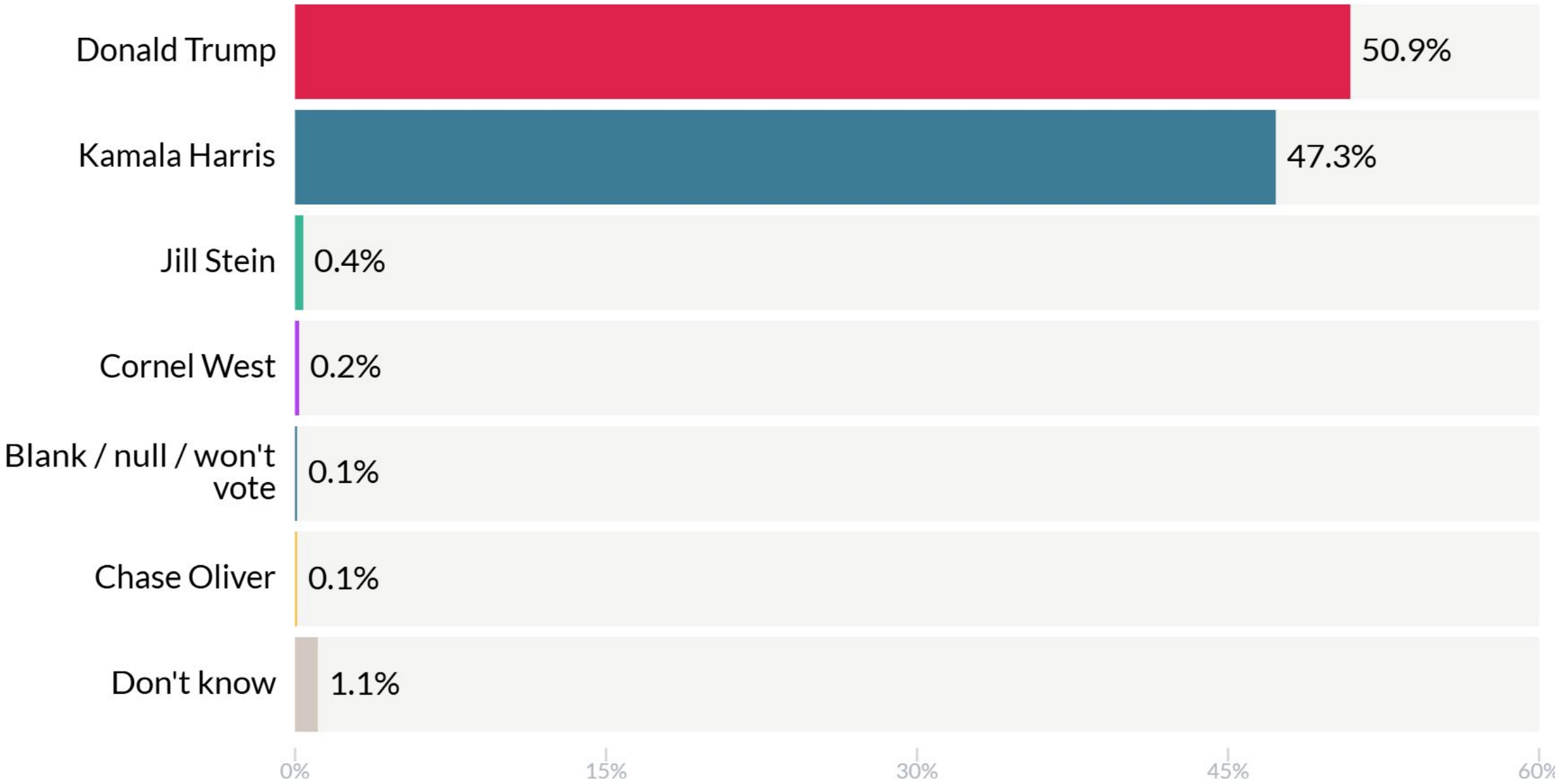

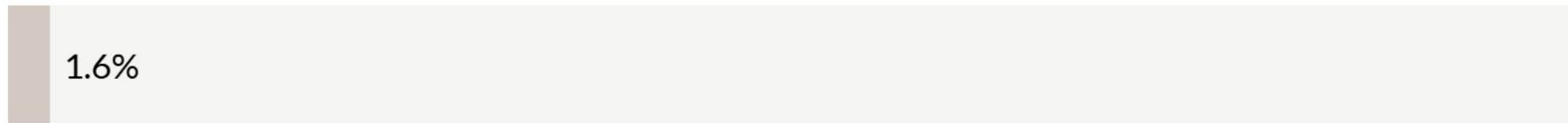

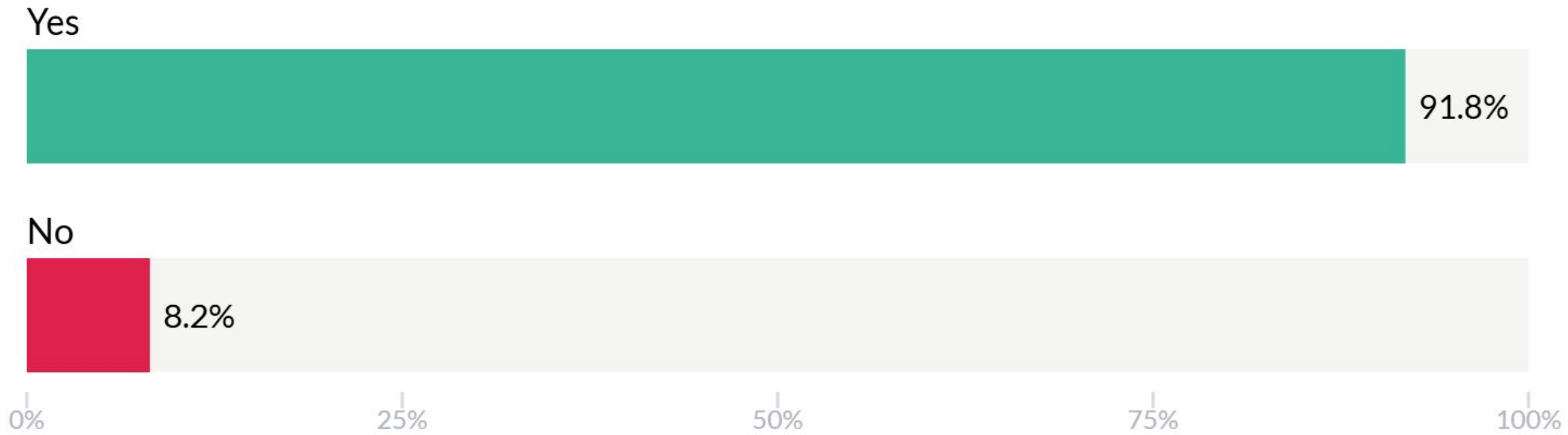

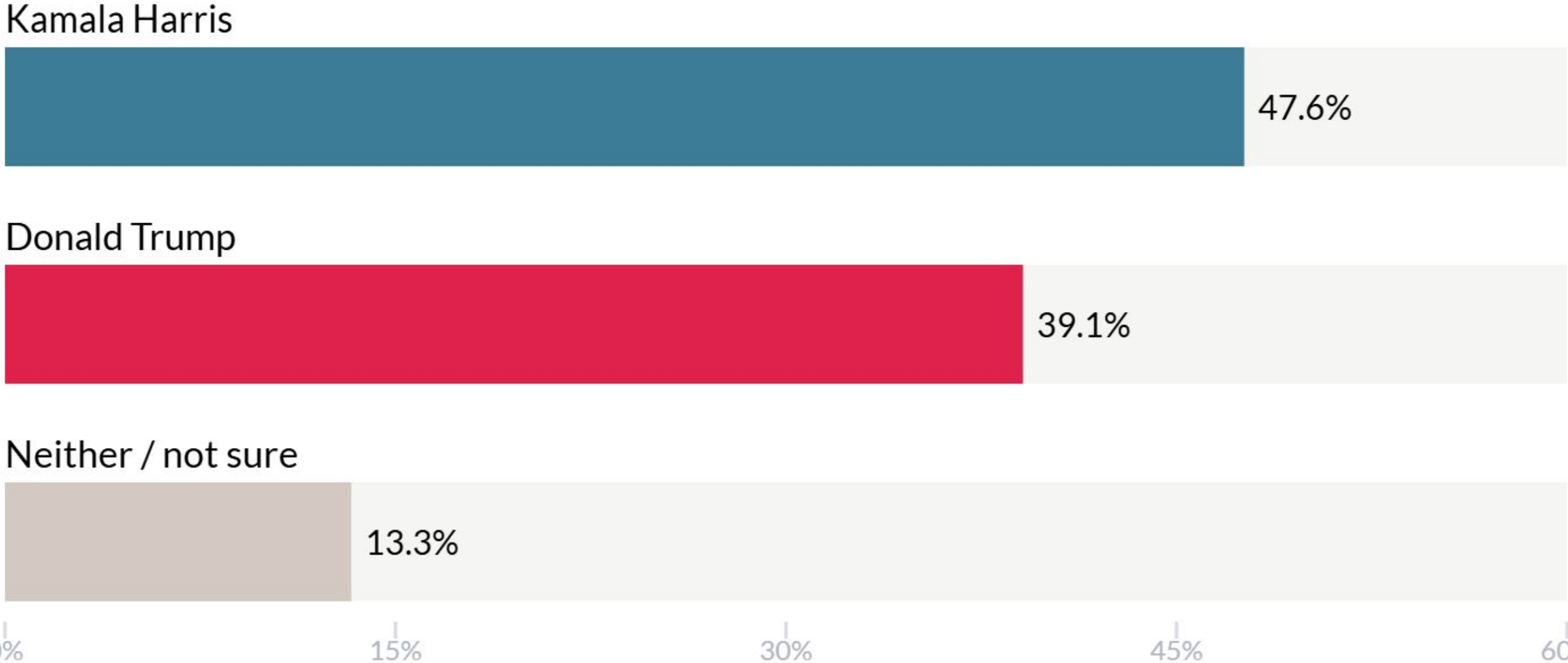

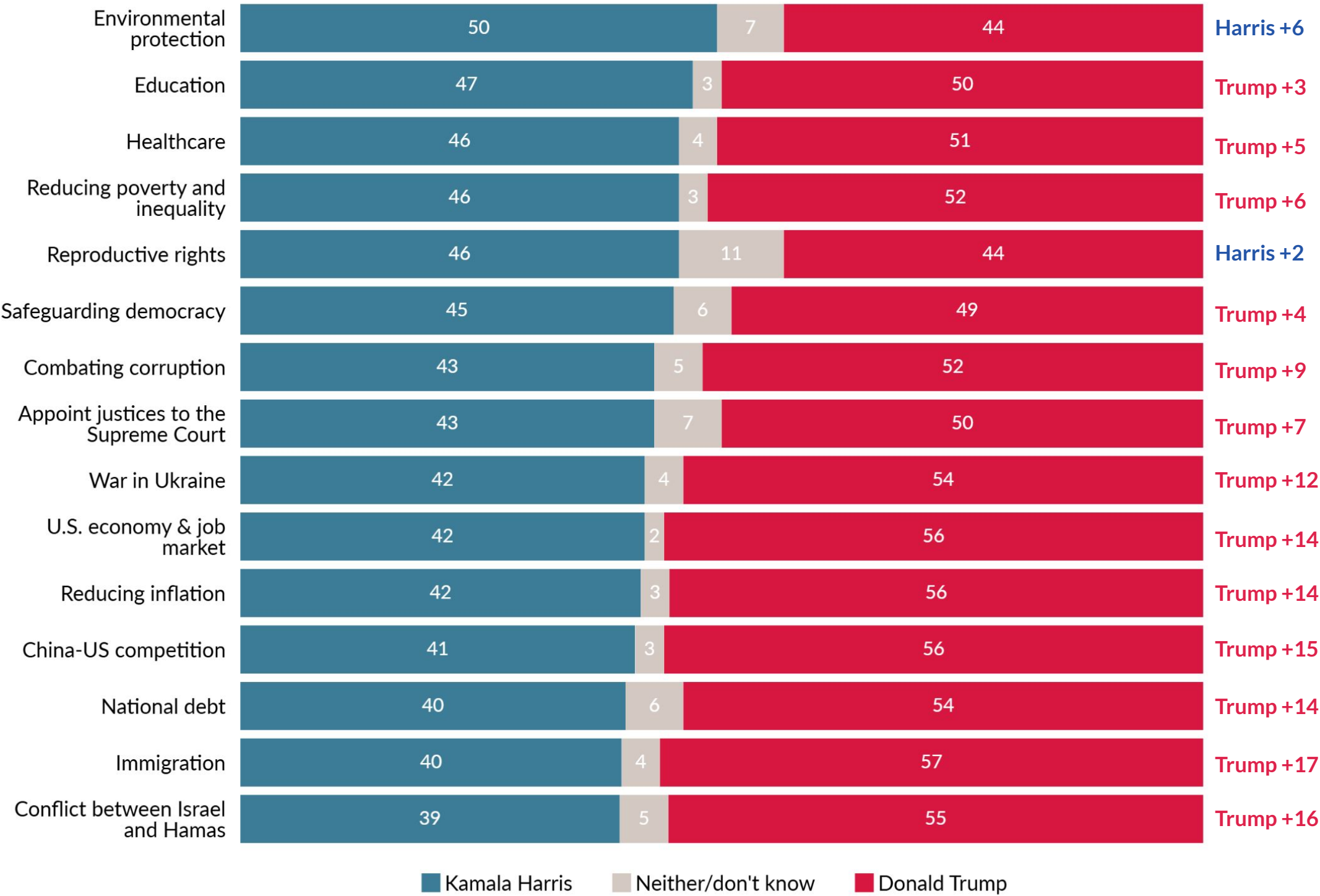

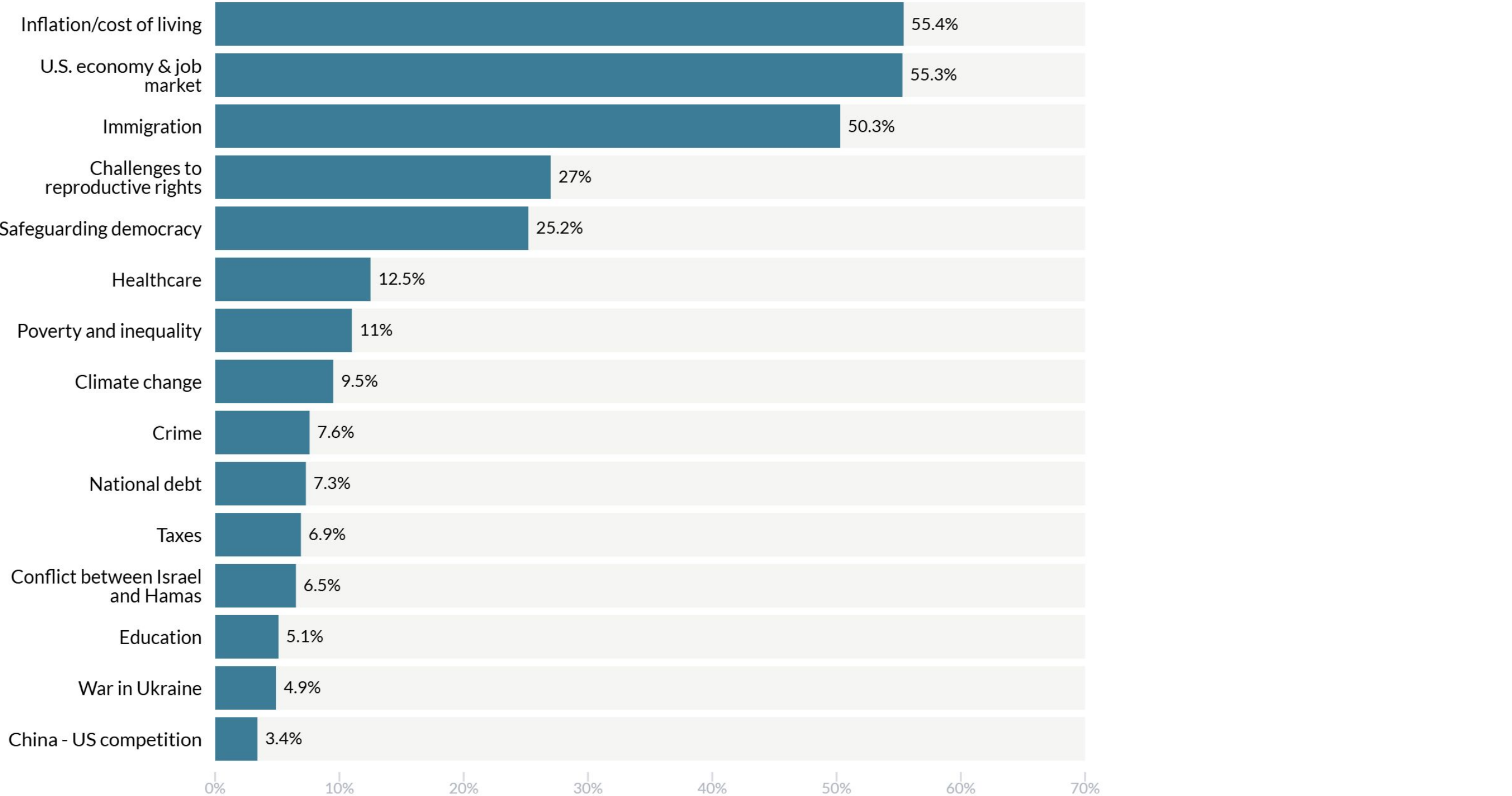

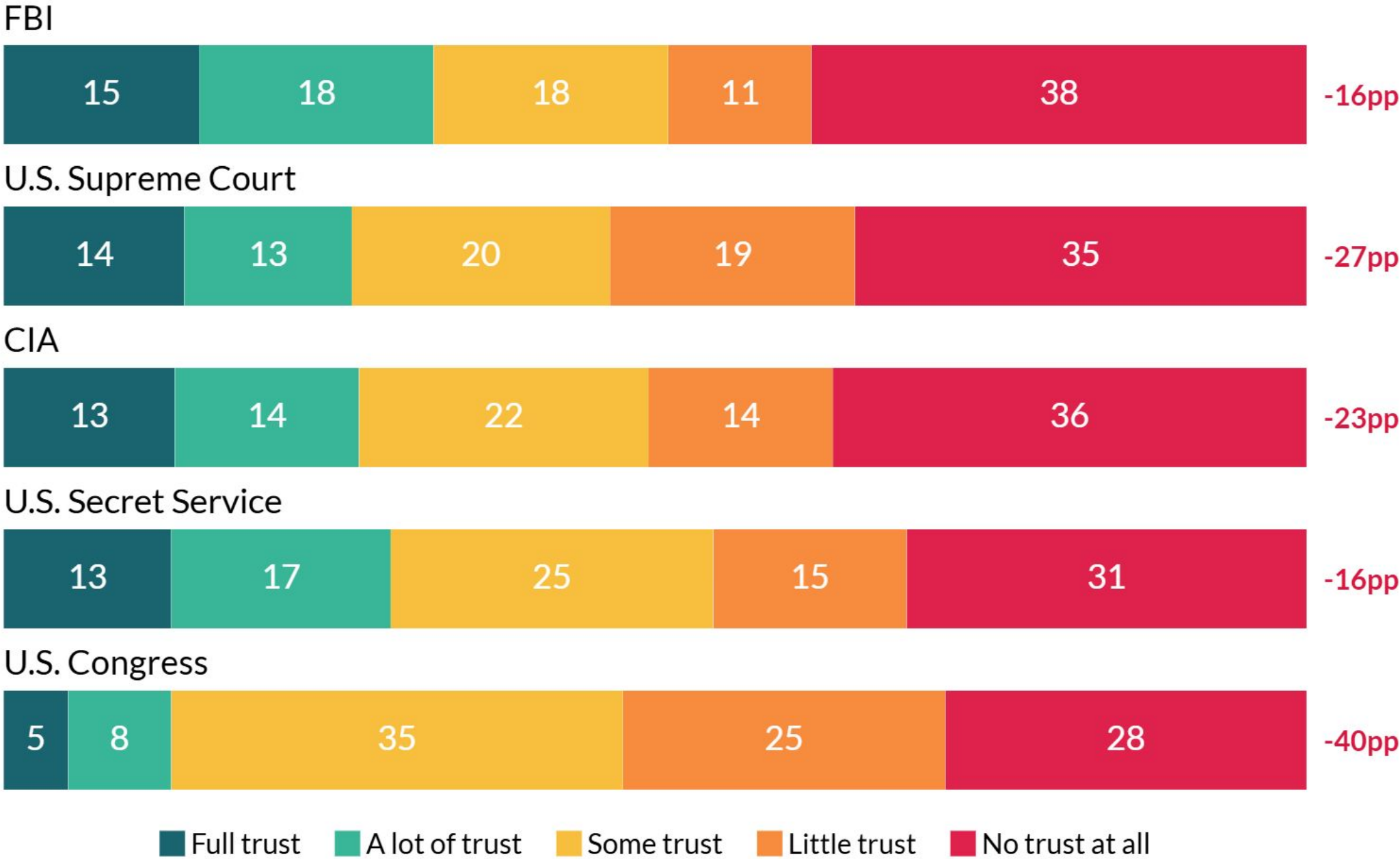

Confidence in institutions [Demographic crossings]



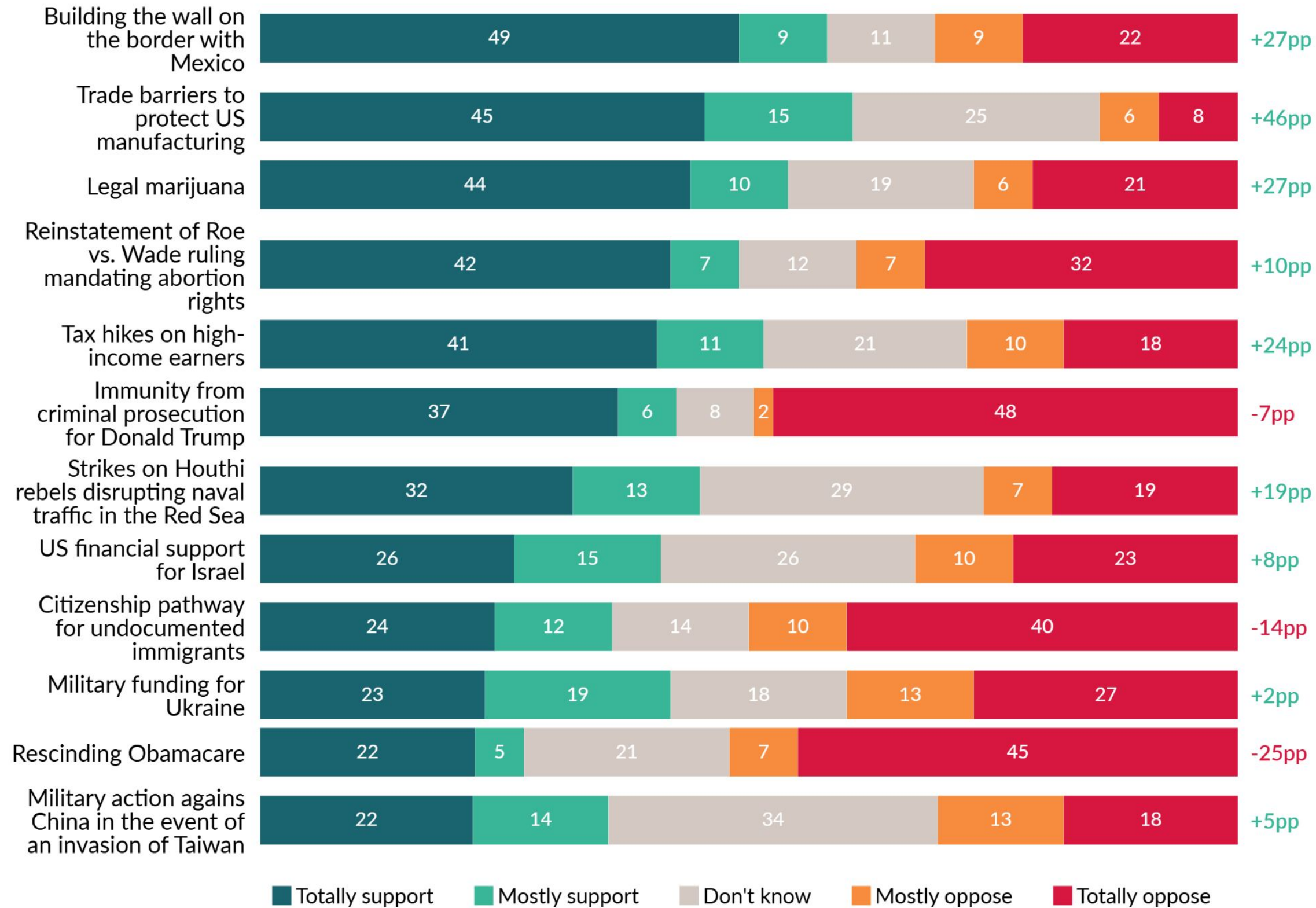

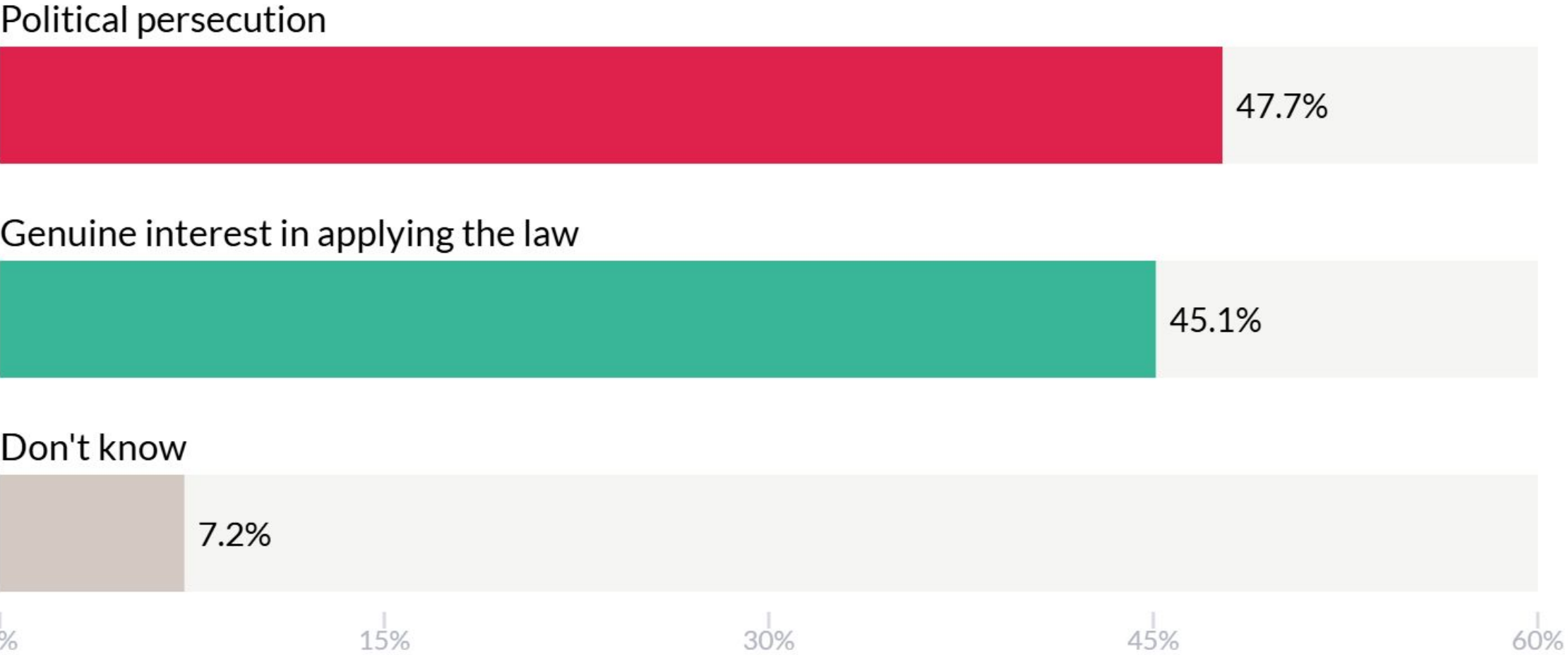

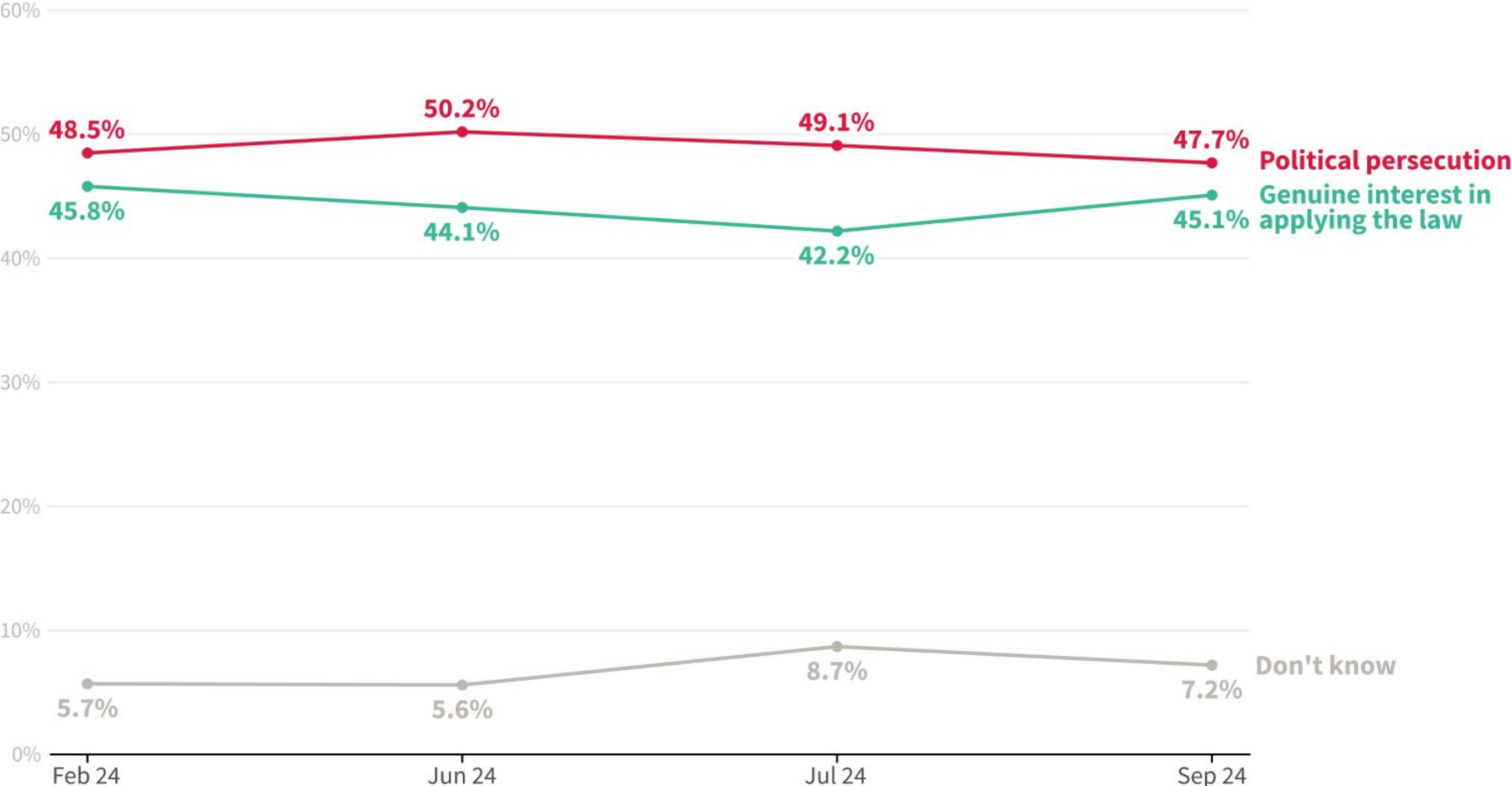

Fairness of judicial proceedings against Trump [Demographic crossings]

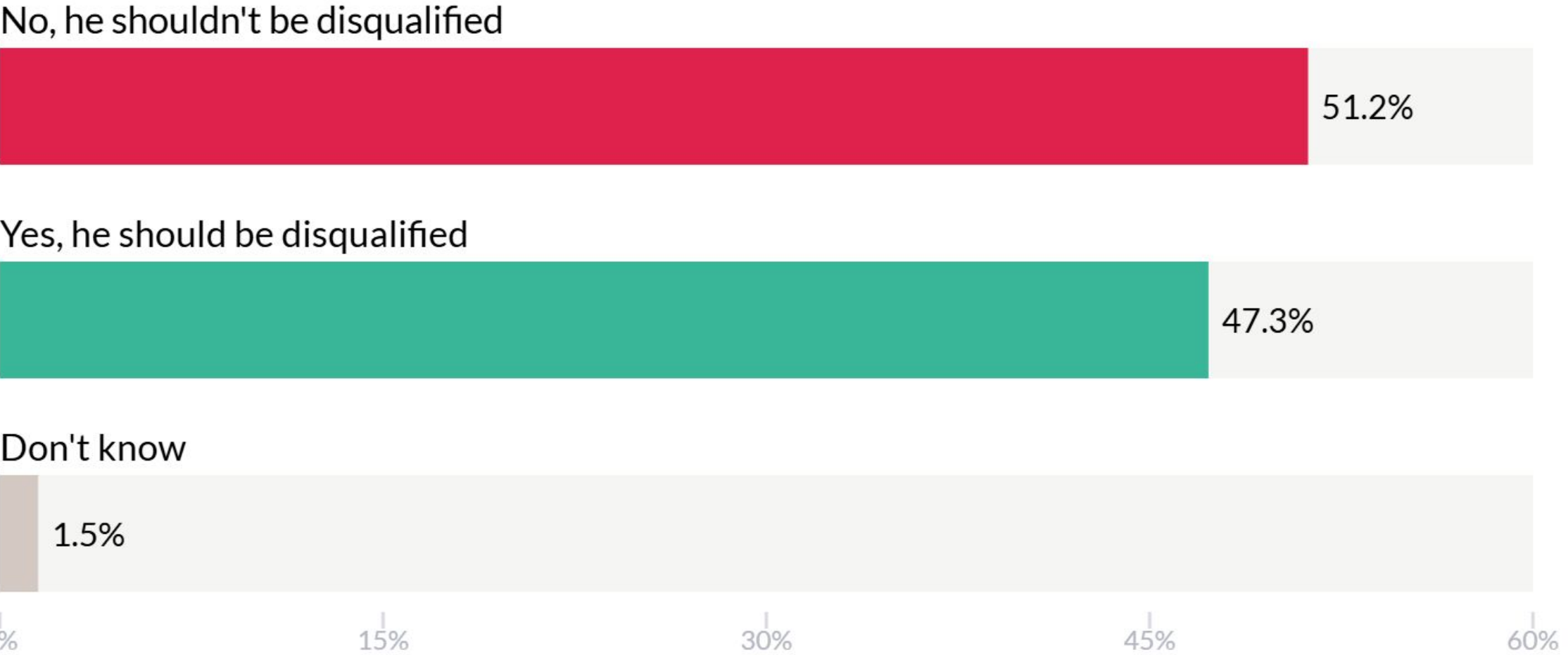

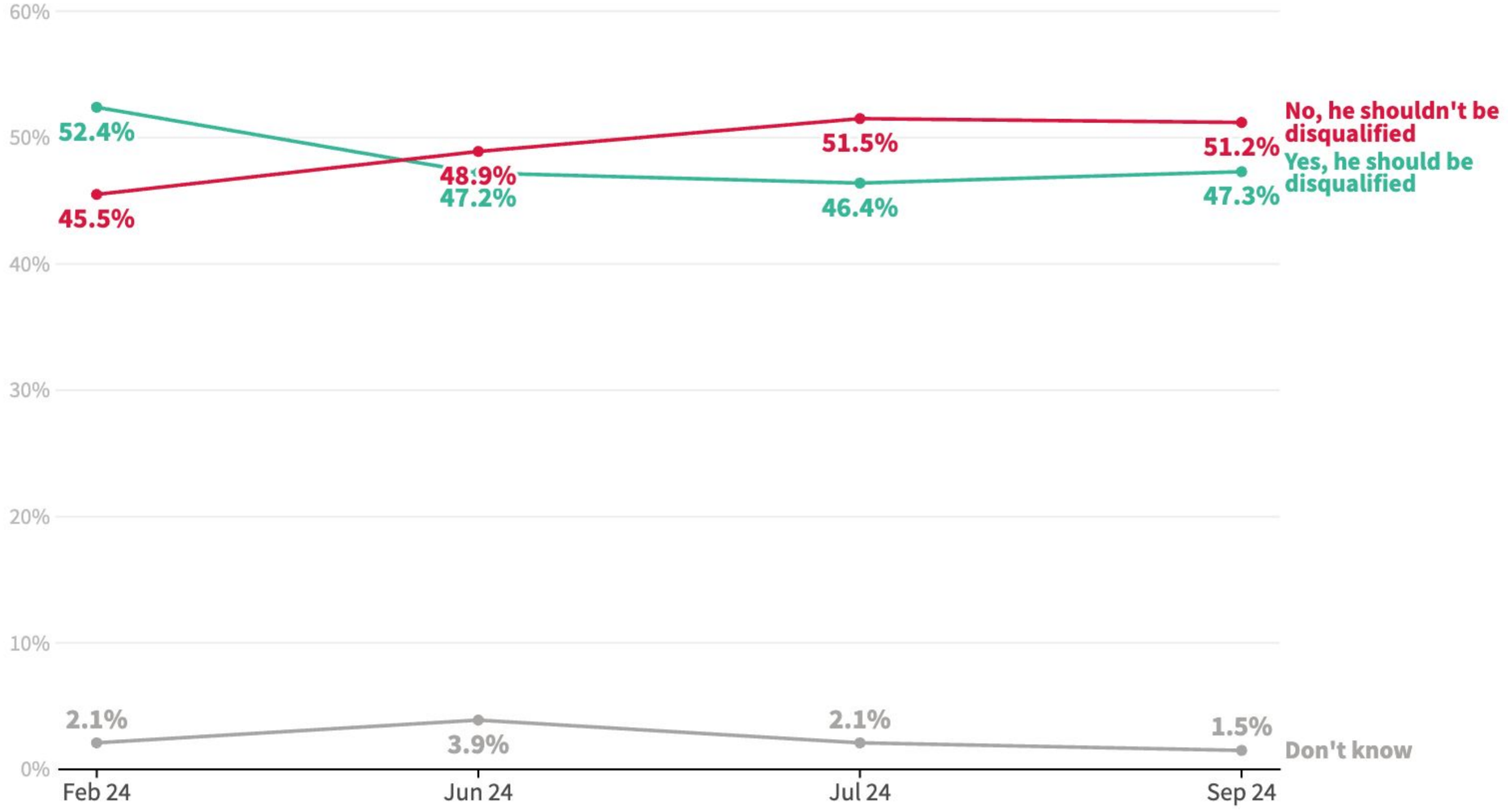

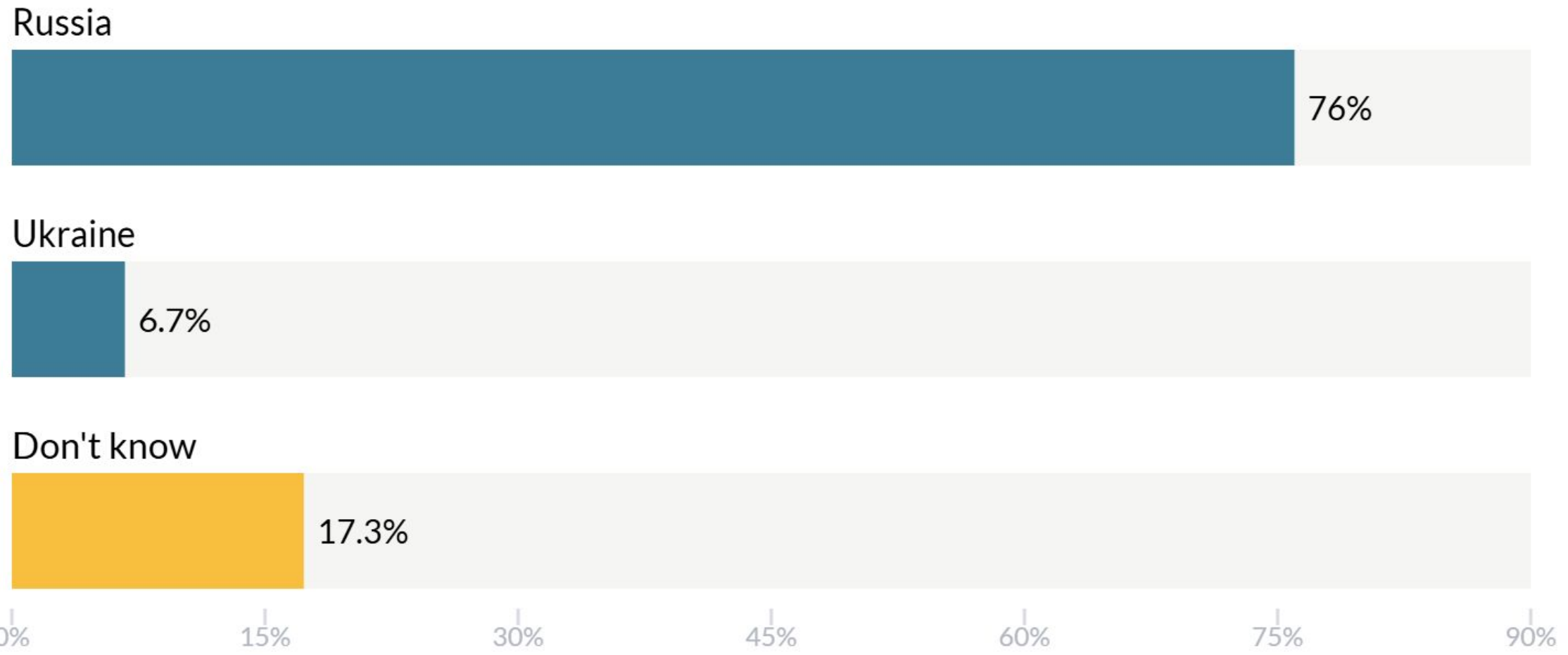

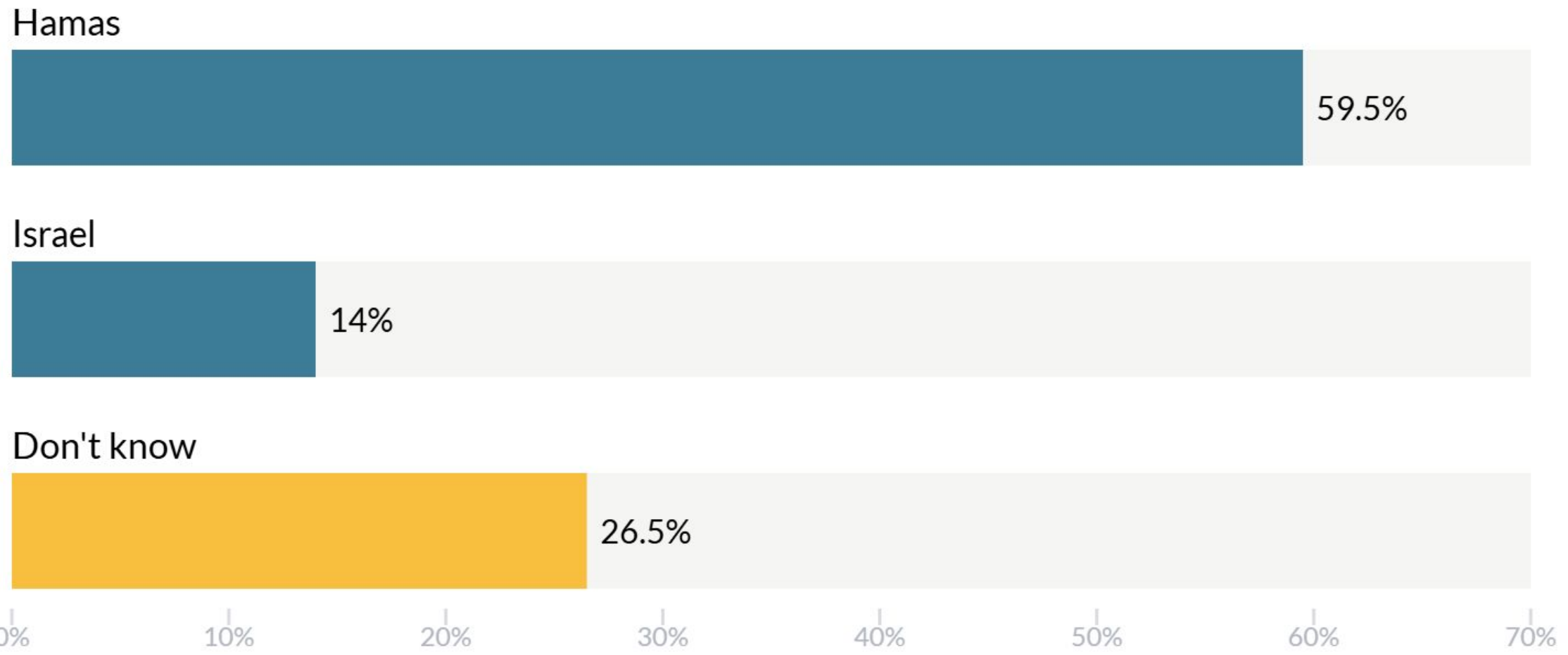

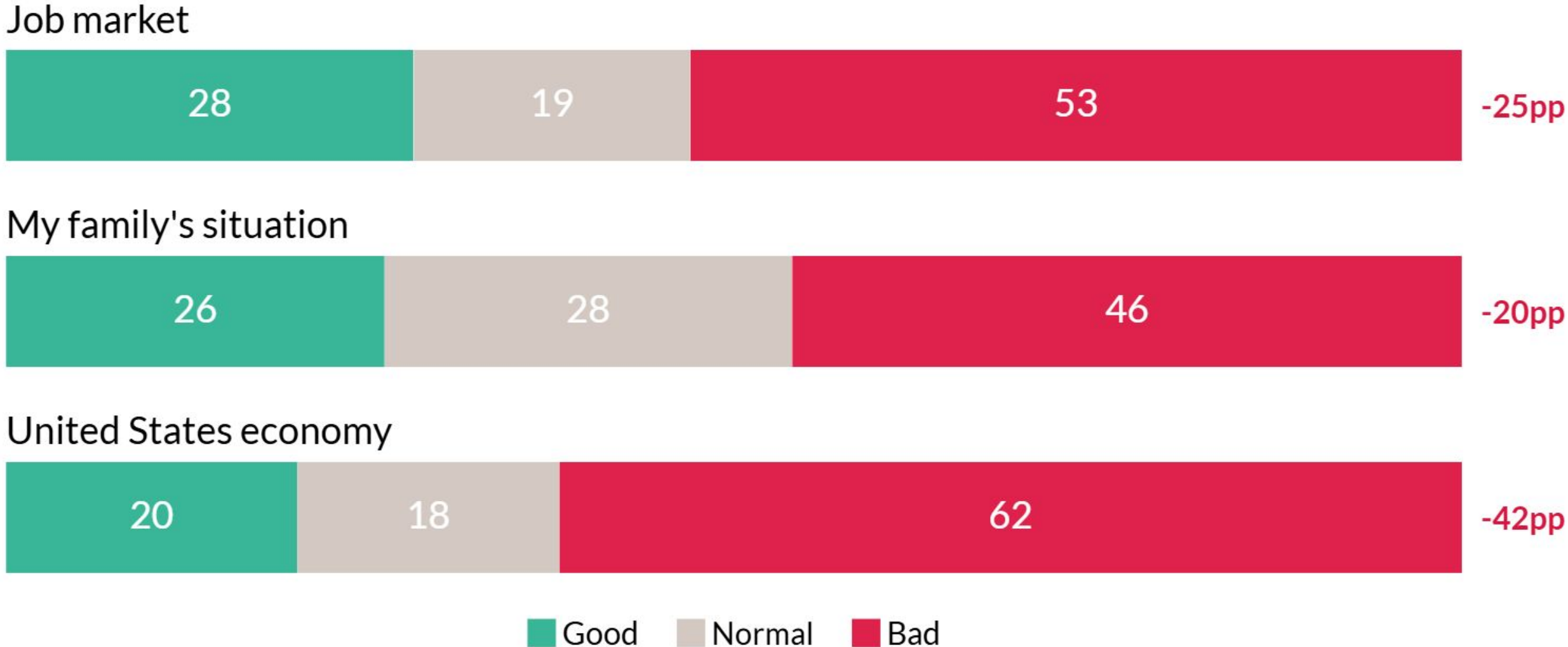

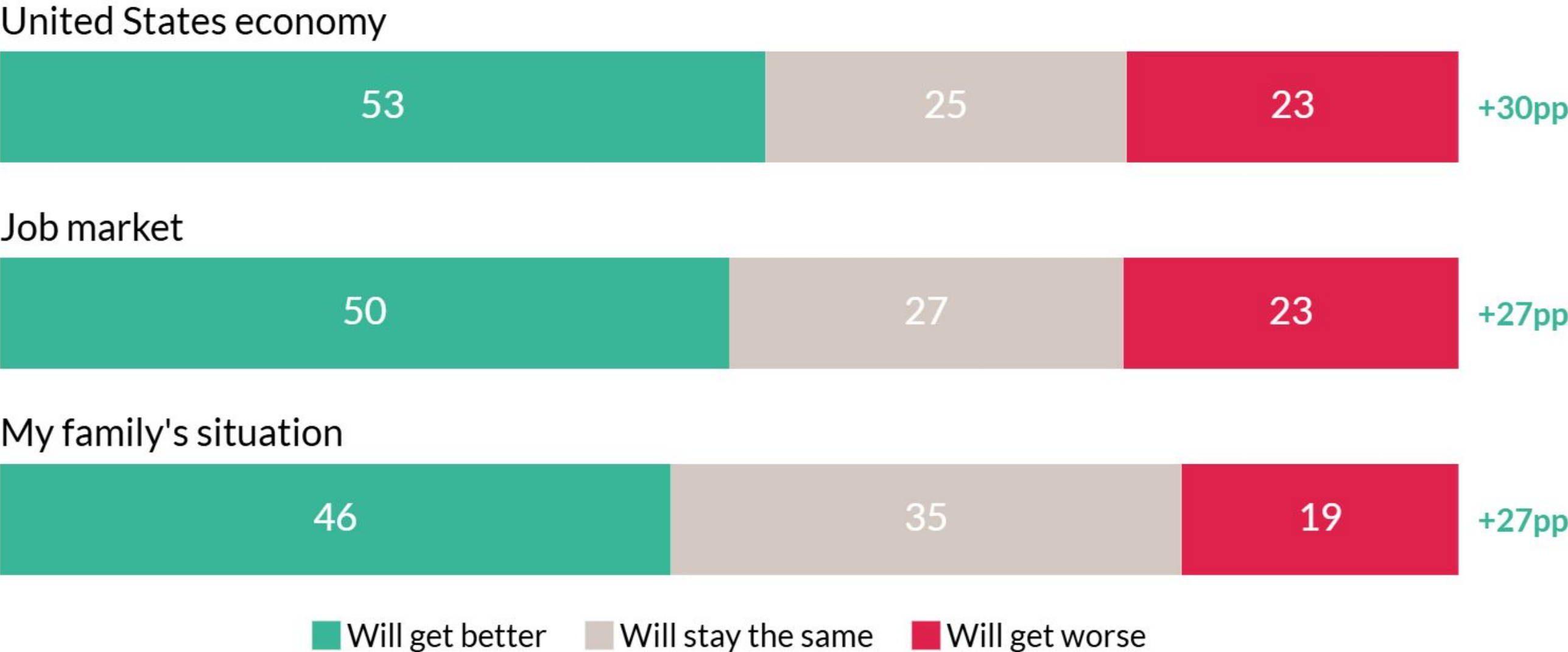

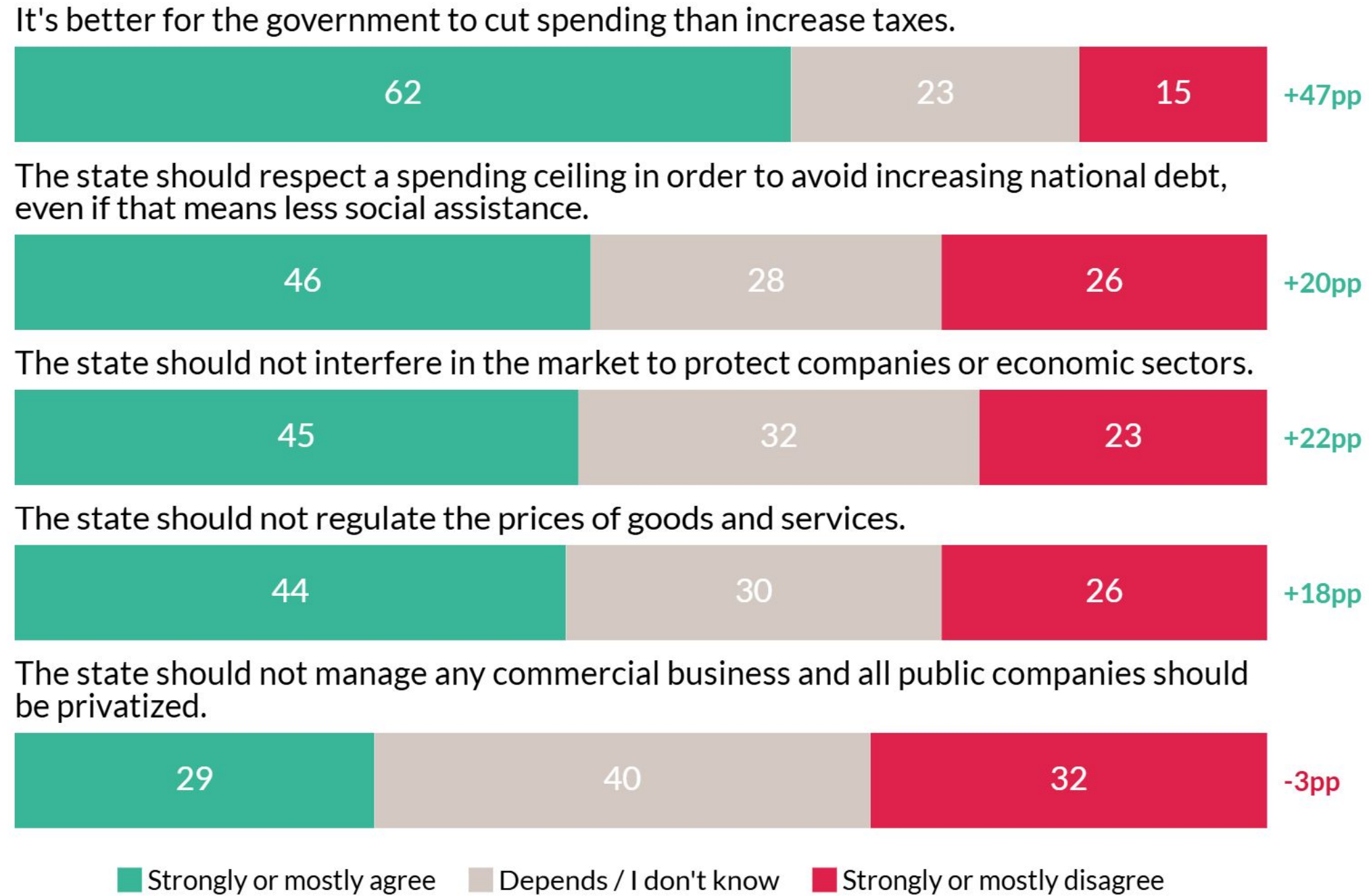

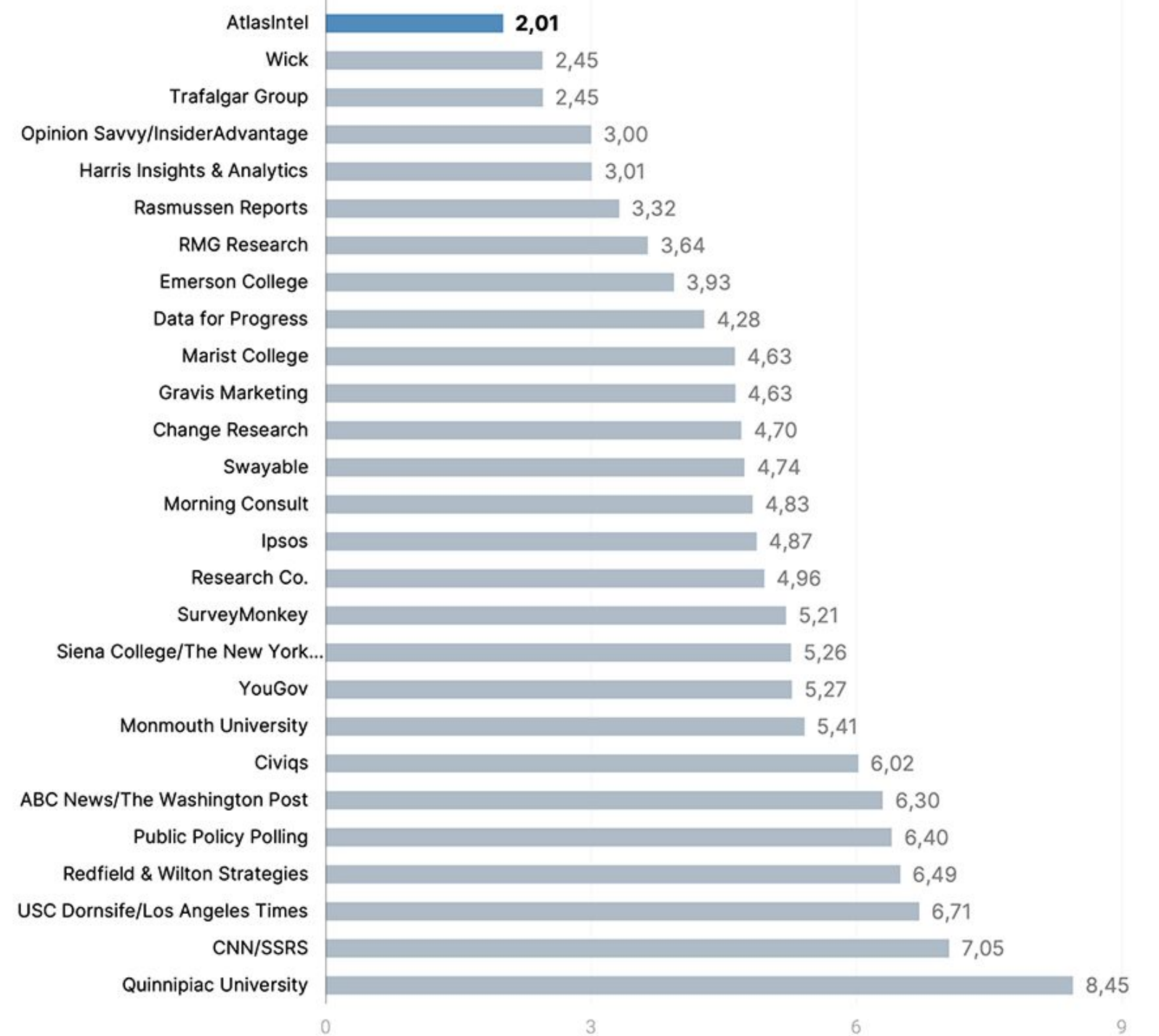

Public and private AtlasIntel polls accurately captured the dynamics of voter mobilization and came closer to the final vote count than any competitor.

AtlasIntel public releases both before and after the start of the poll blackout period indicated that slightly more than 58% of Chilean voters would vote to reject the new constitution; with 61,8% of votes cast against the new constitutional text, AtlasIntel came closest to the final outcome regardless of whether one considers polls released before or during the blackout period.

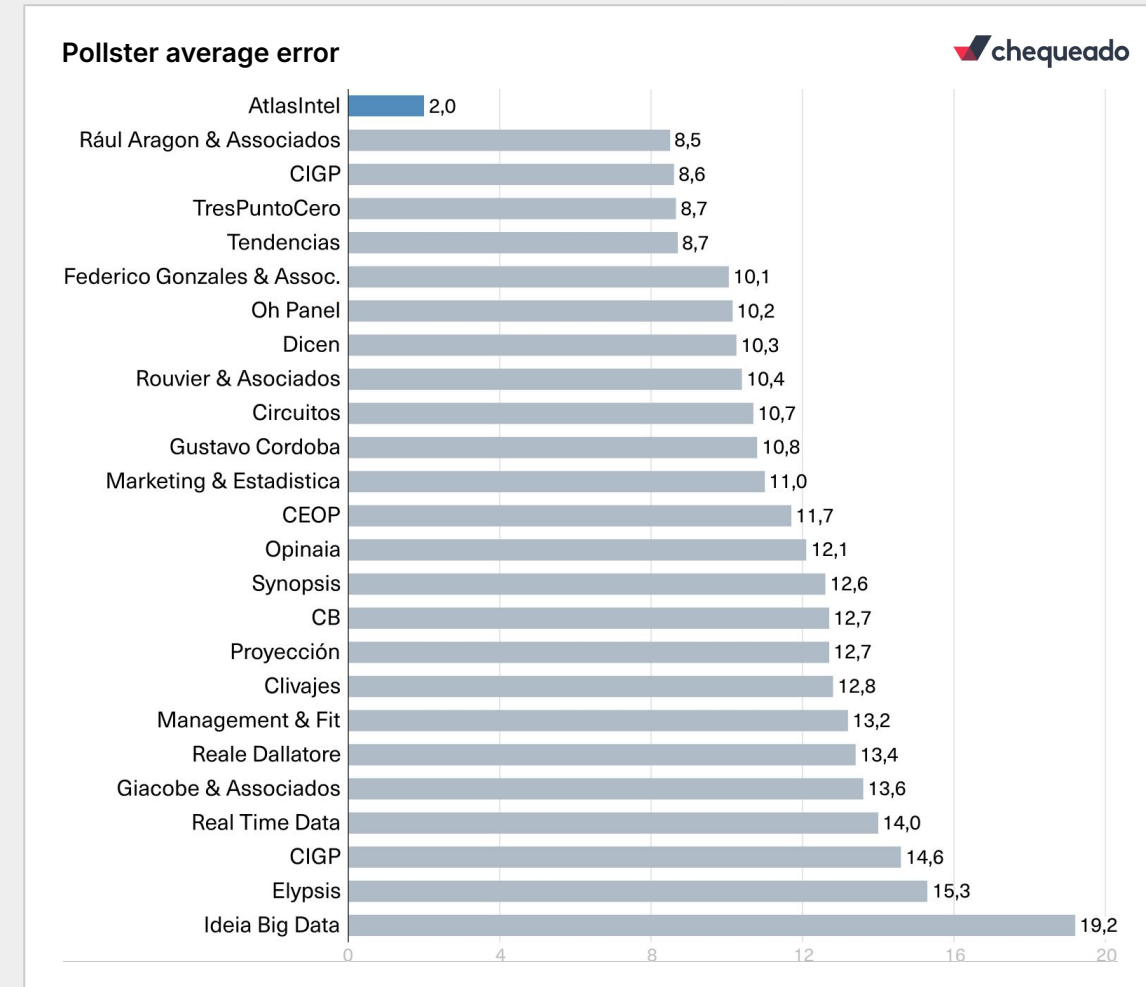

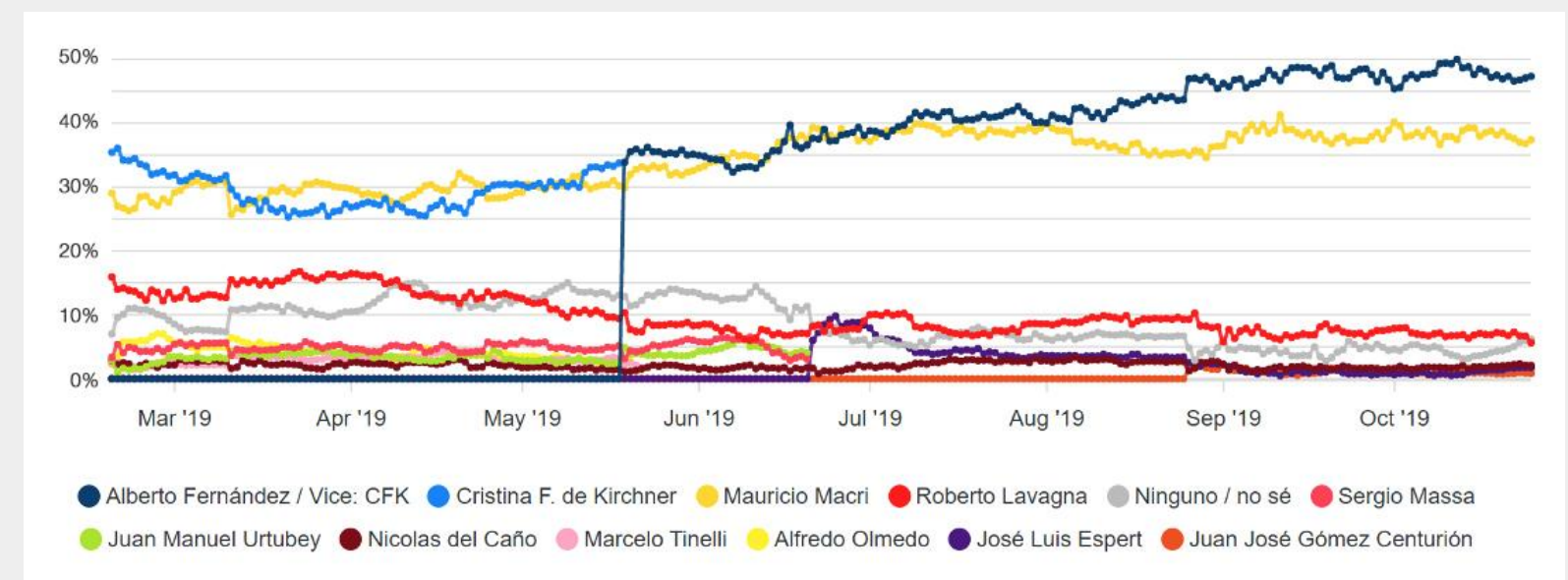

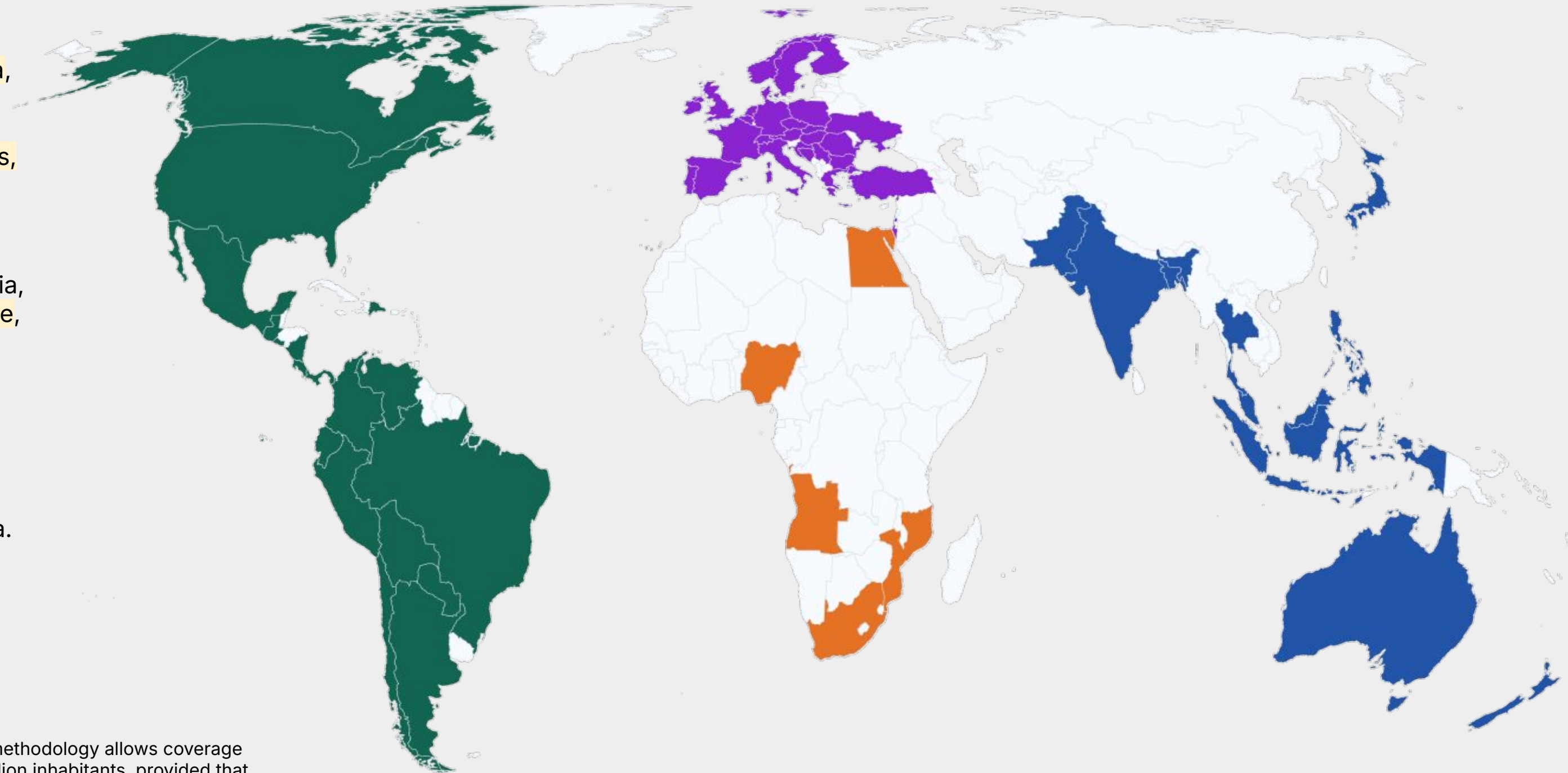
