Survey conducted October 2 through October 3, 2024. 753 likely 2024 General Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2024 General Election. Margin of Error is

+/-3.2% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Survey conducted by Remington Research Group on behalf of Missouri Scout.

Q1: Candidates in the November General Election for Governor of Missouri are Republican Mike Kehoe, Democrat Crystal Quade, and Libertarian Bill Slantz. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

Mike Kehoe: 51% Crystal Quade: 41% Bill Slantz: 1% Undecided: 7%

Q2: Candidates in the November General Election for Treasurer of Missouri are Republican Vivek Malek, Democrat Mark Osmack, and Libertarian John Hartwig Jr. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

Vivek Malek: 50% Mark Osmack: 40% John Hartwig Jr: 2% Undecided: 9%

Q3: Candidates in the November General Election for Attorney General of Missouri are Republican Andrew Bailey, Democrat Elad Gross, and Libertarian Ryan Munro. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

Andrew Bailey: 51% Elad Gross: 42% Ryan Munro: 1% Undecided: 6%
