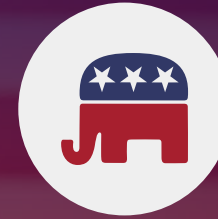

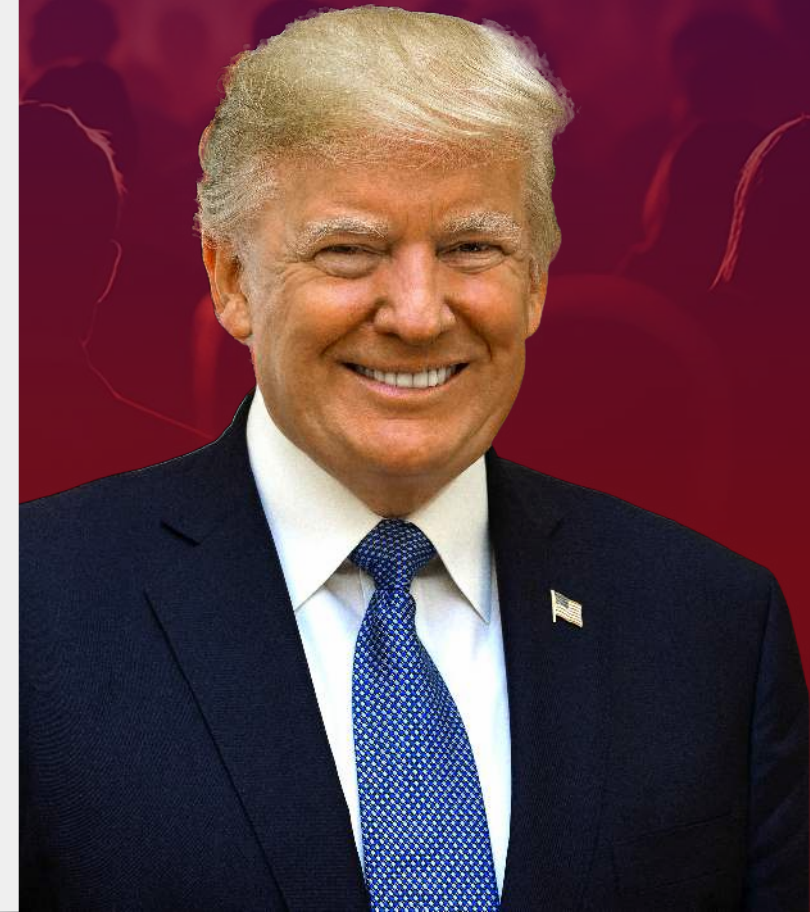

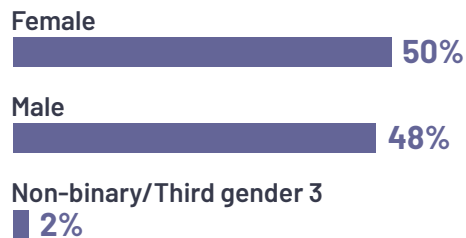


Methodology

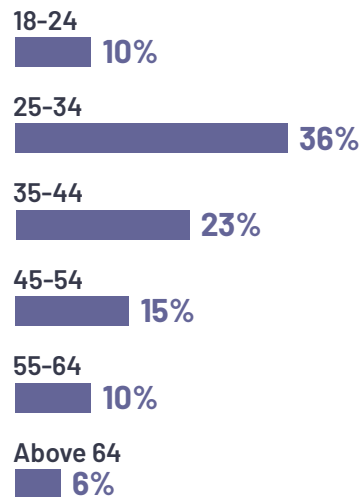
The survey was conducted over a **two-week period from September 27th to October 16th**, utilizing online platforms to reach a diverse sample of voters. **A total of 2,540 registered voters** participated in the survey, ensuring a broad representation across various demographics. The online format allowed for efficient data collection and enabled respondents to provide their input from the convenience of their locations. The focus was on gathering opinions from a wide array of age groups, ethnic backgrounds, and voting histories, ensuring that the results reflect a comprehensive snapshot of current voter sentiment.

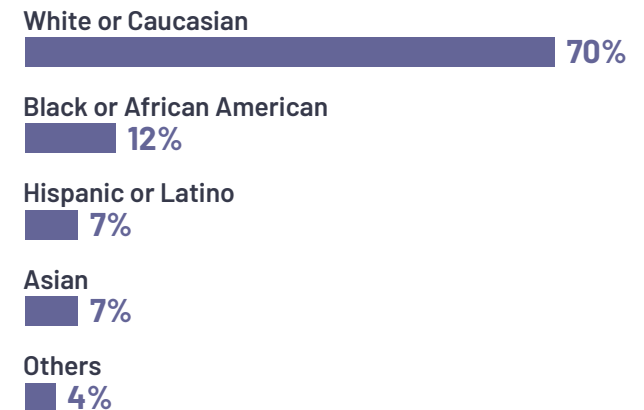

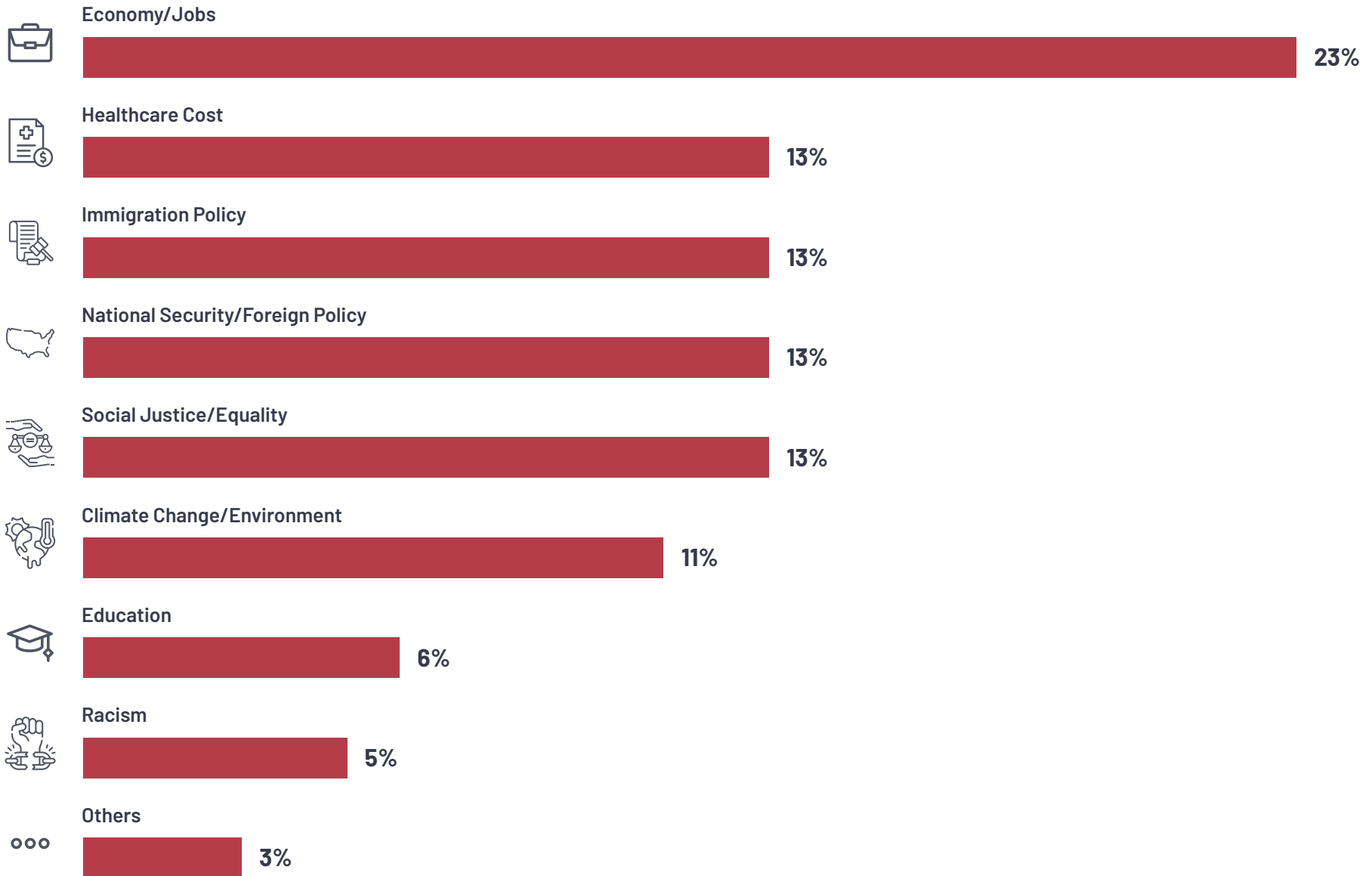


SURVEY RESULTS: ETHNICITY INCLINATION FORECAST (2024)
